PRICING & REGISTRATION

 - **Half-Day:** \$1,175 (non-residents \$1,205)
- RTSD Prorated Fees*:
 - Extended School Year (ESY): \$1,290
 - Literacy/Reading Camp: \$1,325
 - English Language Learners (ELL): \$1,325
 - Social Skills Camp: \$1,390
