

SKATBOARDING CLINICS SPRING 2022



This is an instructional clinic-style clinic taught by local skater Carl Cortez and is for beginner and intermediate street skateboarders in grades 1 to 8. Beginner skaters will develop stance, turning and pushing, while building healthy confidence on your board! Intermediate skaters will develop ollies, flip tricks, and more! All skaters will learn about skateboarding and park etiquette, safety, and fundamentals over the course of 5 sessions. Fun skate games too! In addition to the Radnor Skatepark, portions of the clinic may take place in the parking lot next to the Radnor Skatepark in order to provide a spacious environment conducive to learning and practicing skills. Pre-registration is required for this program - space is limited!. Equipment is not provided, you must bring your own skateboard. Safety gear is recommended.
