WATER RESCUE EQUIPMENT FOR TOWNSHIP

The following equipment was purchased:

Eighteen (18) Stearns Search & Rescue Flotation Vests (Large)

Eighteen (18) Stearns Search & Rescue Flotation Vests (X-Large)

Eighteen (18) Stearns lo23 90' Ring Buoy Ropes with Bag

Eighteen (18) Stearns 24" Orange Ring Buoys with Reflective Tape

Eighteen (18) TFS XL Mesh Turnout Gear Bags

The above equipment was placed into all the marked and unmarked patrol vehicles, as well as, the Chief's and Lieutenants' vehicles.

Each vehicle has one (1) large flotation vest, one (1) extra-large flotation vest, one (1) 90' ring buoy rope in a bag and one (1) 24" ring buoy, all contained inside a mesh turnout gear bag.

WATER RESCUETRAINING COMPLETED!

Elder Technical Rescue Services Company provided the PA Fish and Boat Commission's "Water Rescue for the First Responder Awareness Level" class, which included a review of the department's water safety equipment and the proper way to deploy the equipment. The training included student manuals and certificates issued by the PA Fish and Boat Commission.

Four (4) classes were held from February 14th through March 1, 2019.

Forty-four (44) police officers received the training.
