

- Cost-Saving Approaches Implemented as Possible










#### **Ardrossan Trails**

Site visits, concept plan revisions, neighbor meetings, advisory committee meetings, Township Staff Traffic meeting, two public workshops, Park and Recreation Board meetings and related tasks.

Schedule: February 2016 – June 2019

Project Scope: New Trail Construction		
NLT Services:	Design updates, engineering RFP, oversight of detailed design, landscape plan, construction coordination	\$55,500
Engineer (TBD):	Engineered design of trail, stormwater management and associated structures	\$75-100K
Construction:	Construction of trail, bridges, stormwater management systems, related infrastructure	\$700K to \$1M
TOTAL COST:	Bond: \$356K +/- Remainder: Grant funding, potentially including DCNR, DVRPC, PECO, PennDOT, private foundations	\$1.1M +/-
