

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-16

RADNOR TOWNSHIP

AN ORDINANCE OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, UPDATING AND CODIFYING CHAPTER 270, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RADNOR AND ESTABLISHING FINES AND PENALITES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

Section 1.

Chapter 270, Vehicles and Traffic, is hereby enacted to read as follows:

**Chapter 270
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

**ARTICLE I
GENERAL PROVISIONS**

§270-1. Definitions and interpretation.

- A. Words and phrases, when used in this Chapter, except for sections or articles to which different or additional definitions apply, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. §101 *et seq.* (the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81), as amended, except that in this Chapter the word “street” may be used interchangeably with the word “highway” and shall have the same meaning as the word “highway” as defined in the Vehicle Code.
- B. The term “legal holidays,” as used in this Chapter, shall mean and include New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
- C. The term “parking meter” as used in this Chapter, shall mean any mechanical device which is installed for the purpose of regulating parking spaces in the Township. The term includes, but is not limited to, coin operated parking meters and parking kiosks which accept multiple forms of payment.
- D. In this Chapter, the singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular, and the masculine shall include the feminine.

§270-2. Manner of adopting permanent traffic and parking regulations.

All traffic and parking regulations of a permanent nature shall be enacted as ordinances or parts of ordinances, or as amendments to ordinances of the Township of Radnor.

§270-3. The provisions of this Chapter, so far as they are the same as those of ordinance and regulations in force immediately before the enactment of this Chapter, are intended as a

continuation of those earlier ordinances and regulations and not as new enactments. Nothing in this Chapter shall affect any act done or liability incurred, or any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted under any of these repealed, modified or superceded ordinances or regulations.

§270-4. Temporary and emergency regulations.

- A. The Police Superintendent shall have the powers to regulate traffic and parking temporarily and in time of emergency:
 - 1) In the case of fire, flood, storm, or other emergency, to establish temporary traffic and/or parking regulations.
 - 2) In the case of emergency public works or public events of limited scope or duration, to restrict or prohibit traffic and/or parking in limited areas for periods of not more than 72 hours.
- B. These temporary and emergency regulations shall be enforced by the Radnor Township Police Department in the same manner as permanent regulations. Any person who drives or parks a vehicle in violation of any such regulation or who shall move, remove, destroy, injure or deface any sign or marking erected, posted or made to give notice of any such regulation shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable to the penalty set forth in the law or elsewhere in this Chapter for a violation of such nature.

§270-5. Experimental regulations.

- A. The Board of Commissioners may, from time-to-time, designate places upon and along the streets in the Township where, for a period of not more than 90 days, specific traffic and/or parking regulations, prohibitions and restrictions shall be in force and effect and shall designate those locations by proper signs and markings. Such regulations, prohibitions and restrictions shall be effective just as if they had been specified in this Chapter. No person shall drive or park a vehicle in violation of any such regulation, prohibition or restriction, and no person shall move, remove, or destroy or deface any sign or marking erected, posted or made by authority of this Section. Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall, upon conviction, be liable to the penalty set out in the law or elsewhere in this Chapter for a violation of such nature.
- B. The purpose of this Section is to allow for test and experimental determination of the feasibility and desirability of permanent changes in the ordinances of the Township relative to traffic and parking.

§270-6. Streets closed or restricted for construction, maintenance or special events.

- A. The Board of Commissioners shall have authority to close any street or specific part of a street to vehicular traffic and to place barriers or station police officers at each end of the closed portion, while construction or maintenance work is under way or a special event is

being conducted on the closed portion. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon any such closed portion.

- B. The Board of Commissioners shall have authority to establish a restricted traffic area upon any street where construction or maintenance work is under way and to station flagmen at each end of the restricted portion. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon any such restricted traffic area at any time when the flagman is displaying a sign directing that vehicle to stop or its signaling that vehicle, by flag or other device, not to proceed.

§270-7. Authority of police officers.

The police shall have authority to direct traffic on the streets of the Township, at intersections in public and in other places where the Vehicle Code or this Chapter applies.

**ARTICLE II
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS**

§270-8. Speed limits.

- A. The speed limit for both directions of traffic along the streets or parts thereof described below is hereby established at the rate of speed indicated. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that street or part of a street.

§ 270-9. Traffic control signals.

Traffic control signals shall be installed and operated at the intersections of those streets described below.

§ 270-10. Prohibited right turns on a red signal.

No person shall make a right turn (or a left turn from a one-way street into another one-way street) when facing a steady red signal at any of the locations described below.

§ 270-11. Prohibited turns at intersections.

A. It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to make a turn of the kind designated (left, right, all) at any of the intersections described below.

It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to make a U-turn on any of the streets or parts of streets described below.

§ 270-13. One-way streets.

A. The streets or parts of streets described below are hereby designated as one-way streets in the direction indicated, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any one-way street other than in the direction established for traffic on that street.

§ 270-14. No-passing zones.

No-passing zones are hereby established along those streets or parts of streets described below, and it shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to overtake or pass another vehicle or to drive on the left side of the roadway in any no-passing zone described below.

§ 270-15. Through streets.

The streets or parts of streets below are hereby established as through streets, and the driver of any vehicle, upon approaching any such street at any intersection thereof (except for such intersections where there are now or shall hereafter be located official traffic signals), shall come to a full stop or yield the right-of-way, as the case may be, before entering any such through street.

§ 270-16. Stop intersections.

- A. The intersections described below (in addition to intersections with the through streets established by this Chapter), are hereby established as stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected in such a position upon the first-named street as to face traffic approaching the second-named street in the direction or directions indicated. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first-named or stop street, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. 3323(b), and shall not proceed into or across the second-named or intersecting or through street until he/she has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the law.

§ 270-17. Yield intersections.

A. The intersections described below (in addition to intersections with the through streets established by this Chapter), are hereby established as yield intersections, and official yield signs shall be erected in such a position upon the first-named street as to face traffic approaching the second-named street in the direction or directions indicated. Every driver of a vehicle approaching any such intersection upon the first-named street, in the direction or directions indicated in each case, shall slow down or stop the vehicle and then yield the right-of-way to any vehicle in the intersection or approaching on the second-named street so closely as to constitute a hazard during the time that the driver is moving across or within such intersection.

§ 270-21. Motor vehicles driven on sidewalks.

No person shall operate a motor vehicle or tractor upon any sidewalk in the Township, nor shall any person operate a motor vehicle upon or across any sidewalk except in order to gain access to or egress from a driveway or alley at such locations where the curb, if such sidewalk is curbed, shall have been properly cut down for the purpose.

§ 270-22. Operation of motor vehicles on closed highways.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any vehicle or tractor upon any highway in the Township that is under construction, resurfacing or repair, in disregard of any official sign, barricade or notice that the same is closed to vehicular traffic.

B. Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall pay a fine pursuant to the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.

§ 270-23. Accident reports.

The operator of any motor vehicle involved in an accident in the Township and required by law to report such accident to any department or agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or any other person required to make such report, shall at the time of making such report to the Commonwealth, make a written report to the Radnor Township Police Department containing the same information.

270-24. Open vehicles prohibited.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any loaded open commercial vehicle or other loaded open commercial tractor, trailer, tractor-trailer combination, dump or pickup truck without first having the same covered and any load contained therein covered and secured with a tarp to prevent and prohibit any portion whatsoever of its load escaping from the bed of said vehicle. Exempted hereunder are equipment or similar loads incapable of escaping from said vehicle.

B. Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall pay a fine pursuant to the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.

**ARTICLE III
PARKING REGULATIONS**

§ 270-25. Vehicles to be parked within marked spaces.

Wherever a space is marked off on any street for the parking of an individual vehicle, every vehicle parked there shall be parked wholly within the lines bounding that space, and it shall be a violation of this Article for any person to park a vehicle or allow it to remain parked otherwise.

§ 270-26. Angle parking.

No person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts thereof described below except at the angle designated and only within the painted stall lines. On all streets or portions thereof where angle parking is now or shall hereafter be authorized, all vehicles parked thereon shall be parked with the front thereof nearest curb.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, whether principal or agent, to construct any fence, wall or otherwise block or impede means of ingress or egress to the private property of another to such an extent, in such a manner or for such a period of time as to create a hazard or impair public safety.

§ 270-33. RESERVED.

§ 270-34. Permit parking zones.

A. Residential parking permit zones.

- 1) Legislative purpose. It is the legislative purpose of the Board of Commissioners to assist, when feasible, residents of the area of the Township who suffer from vehicular congestion resulting from the existence of limited numbers of curbside parking spaces and large numbers of nonresidents competing with residents for curbside parking spaces and/or from parking regulations designed to control the flow of vehicles which ultimately work a hardship on residents of such areas. The adverse conditions include, but are not limited to, hazardous traffic conditions, air pollution, excessive noise and refuse, unreasonable burdens in gaining access to residences, reduced traffic safety, reduced pedestrian safety, particularly for children and senior citizens, reduced efficiency in the movement of emergency vehicles and general reduction in the quality of life.
- 2) As used in this Section, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

PARKING PERMIT – Either a resident parking permit or a visitor parking permit authorized by this Section.

PERMIT PARKING DISTRICT – An area of the Township which may also be described as along a specific street, which is zoned predominantly developed for residential use, where curbside parking either is prohibited or is limited to not more than two consecutive hours by other provisions in this Code, from Monday to Friday, except on legal holidays, which is designated as such a district by an ordinance, and

within which such parking restrictions will be waived for vehicles properly displaying parking permits authorized by this Section.

VEHICLE – An automobile, motorcycle, moped, van or jeep, but does not mean a truck, trailer or camper.

3) Designation of permit parking districts.

(a) The Board of Commissioners may, by ordinance, designate permit parking districts when it determines that residents of the proposed permit parking district are adversely affected by entry into the area and curbside parking by nonresidents in vehicles and/or by parking regulations in effect which are designed to control use of curbside parking, but which work a hardship on area residents, after taking into consideration the following:

[1] The difficulty or inability experienced by residents of the proposed permit parking district in obtaining curbside parking reasonably accessible to their residences;

[2] The likelihood of alleviating such conditions by the use of the permit parking system established by this Section;

[3] The desire of the residents of the proposed parking permit district for the institution of a permit parking system and willingness of those residents to bear the costs incidental to the issuance of parking permits and administration of the permit parking system authorized by this Section; and

[4] The desirability of establishing a permit parking district in view of the proportion of actual residential use to other uses in the proposed permit parking district.

(b) The following are hereby established as special permit parking zones, and it shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle except those displaying an official Radnor Township “permit only” sticker which shall be issued by the Police Department. Permits will be issued only to those persons who can establish that they are full-time residents in a property abutting the zone and that the property in which they reside has no off-street parking.

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- 4) Posting of signs. Upon designation by the Board of a permit parking district, the Township Public Works Department shall erect signs giving notice of the restrictions.
- 5) Issuance of resident parking permits.
 - (a) Subject to the provision of Subsections A(b), (c), (d) and (e) of this Section, the Police Department shall issue to an applicant who has submitted a permit fee of \$10 and a completed permit application form one or two parking permits for up to two vehicles described in the application, provided that the applicant establishes that his off-street parking space is inadequate for such vehicles. If the applicant's property has a driveway, that permit shall be issued only for the second vehicle registered at that address.
 - (b) Except as provided in Subsection A(5)(e) of this Section, no resident parking permit shall be issued for a vehicle unless its owner (or joint owners) and one of its principal operators resides within the permit parking district for which the permit is sought and the residence is in compliance with the single-family provision of Chapter 280, Zoning.
 - (c) Except as provided in Subsection A(5)(e) of this Section, a resident parking permit shall be issued only to an owner (or joint owners) who is also one of the principal operators of the applicable vehicle.
 - (d) Except as provided in Subsection A(5)(e) of this Section, a resident parking permit shall be issued only for a vehicle which is registered to the home address of the applicant within the permit parking district.
 - (e) The provisions of Subsections A(5)(b), (c) and (d) of this Section may be waived when an applicant establishes to the satisfaction of the Police Department that he or she is a resident of the permit parking district for which a permit is sought, that he or she is the principal operator of the motor vehicle for which a permit is sought and that the vehicle is either a leased vehicle or company car supplied to the applicant by his or her employer for general use.
 - (f) Each residential parking permit shall expire on December 31 of the year in which it was issued, unless renewed as set forth below.
- 6) Renewal of residential parking permits. Upon submission by the holder of a resident parking permit of a renewal fee of \$10 and a completed renewal application on or

before the expiration date of the applicable permit, the Police Department shall issue a new resident parking permit to the applicant.

7) Transfer of resident parking permits.

(a) Upon submission by the holder of a resident parking permit of a transfer fee of \$10 or \$5 if the application is filed after June 30 in any year, and a permit transfer application, the Police Department shall issue a transferee who qualifies as a holder of such permit a new resident parking permit for the same vehicle.

(b) The transfer of a resident parking permit shall not affect its expiration date.

8) Issuance of visitors' parking permits.

(a) Upon application of a resident of a permit parking district and submission of a fee of \$5, the Police Department shall issue to the applicant a visitor's parking permit valid for a period not exceeding 90 days for use by bona fide guests of the applicant or by a person doing business with the applicant at his residence, provided that the applicant establishes that his off-street parking space is inadequate for such vehicle.

(b) No more than two visitors' parking permits shall be issued to any one household at any one time, provided that the applicant provides satisfactory proof of sufficient frontage of his property on a public street to accommodate the vehicles permitted.

9) Use of resident parking permits and visitors' parking permits.

(a) All parking permits shall be placed on the back of the inside rear view mirror of the vehicle or displayed in or on vehicles in such a manner as may be prescribed by the Police Department.

(b) A parking permit shall not guarantee or reserve a parking space within a permit parking district. A parking permit shall not authorize the standing or parking of any vehicle in any place (such as next to fire hydrants) where the stopping or parking of vehicles is set aside for specific types of vehicles. A parking permit shall not excuse the nonobservance of any traffic regulation other than a general parking prohibition or a two-hour maximum parking limit, as applicable, then in force in the permit parking district.

(c) Until its expiration, surrender or revocation, a parking permit shall remain valid for such time as the holder continues to reside within the same permit parking district.

(d) Whenever the holder of a parking permit or the vehicle for which the permit was issued no longer fulfills one or more of the applicable provisions of this Section,

the holder shall surrender the parking permit in the manner prescribed by the Police Department. There will be no refunds of any portion of a fee previously paid.

- (e) A parking permit shall be valid only in the permit parking district for which it is issued.
- (f) The person to whom a parking permit is issued shall be responsible for the use or misuse of any parking permit issued to such person.

10) Exemption for the physically disabled. The provisions of this Section shall in no way supersede the provisions of any present or future provisions of the Township Code relating to parking by physically disabled persons.

11) Rules and regulations.

- (a) The Police Department shall promulgate rules and regulations relating to the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this Section.
- (b) When promulgating rules and regulations, the Police Department shall make every reasonable effort to devise methods to preserve the integrity of the permit parking system.

12) Violations and penalties. Any person violating any provision of this Section shall be subject to revocation of his or her permit and, upon summary conviction, be fined \$15 for each violation, together with the costs of prosecution. If the fine is paid voluntarily within five days of the violation, then no costs shall be charged. The amount of any fine paid within five days shall be reduced to \$15, plus costs.

§ 270-37. Vehicles prohibited in parks.

All vehicles shall be prohibited, at all times, in the following Township parks, except those authorized vehicles with written permission of the Department of Public Works.

§ 270-38. Parking violations and penalties.

A. Any person who violates any provision of this Article shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than that specified for violation of said Section.

B. Parking meter violations.

- (1) Expired meter: \$20
- (2) Parked over line at meter: \$20
- (3) Backed into meter space: \$20
- (4) Beyond time limit (meter feeding): \$20

C. Other parking violations. All violations are payable within five days. Coins are not accepted.

- (1) Overtime parking: \$20
- (2) Where signs prohibit parking: \$15
- (3) In front of private drive: \$10
- (4) On a crosswalk: \$10
- (5) Double parking: \$10
- (6) Not parallel with curb: \$10
- (7) Facing against traffic movement: \$10
- (8) On a sidewalk: \$10
- (9) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant: \$10
- (10) Within 25 feet of a street intersection: \$10
- (11) Parked during snow removal: \$10
- (12) Obstructing traffic: \$10
- (13) Handicapped parking: \$150
- (14) Other parking violation: \$10
- (15) Violation of Fire Marshal ordinance (parking): \$25

D. Payment procedure. Any person who receives notice of a violation under Subsections B or C shall pay the penalty imposed for such violation within five days after the date of such notice. Payment for violations shall be made by mailing the ticket along with a check or money order in the amount specified on the ticket or payment may be made at the Radnor Township Municipal Building.

E. Late fee procedure. If Radnor Township has not received payment for a violation within five days after the date of violation, a late fee of \$20 in addition to the fine will be assessed. Failure to pay this fine and/or late fee within 30 days of the violation will result in issuance of a summons and prosecution before a District Justice.

F. Procedure to contest violation. Any person who wishes to contest a violation under this Article shall contact the Office of the District Justice.

G. A notice of violation of any provision of this Article shall be placed on the vehicle parked in violation, such a notice to contain instructions to the owner or operator of such vehicle that, if he shall report to the Police Department of the Township of Radnor and pay the penalty imposed for violation within five days after the time of such notice, or if he shall place such sum within the envelope provided and mail it to the Township within such

time limit, the same shall save the violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine and costs above.

ARTICLE IV

REMOVAL AND IMPOUNDING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES

§ 270-39. Applicability and scope.

This Article is enacted under authority of § 6109(a)(22) of the Vehicle Code and gives authority to the Township to remove and impound vehicles that are parked overtime on any street in the Township, or in metered and unmetered parking lots in the Township, in violation of any provision of this Chapter.

§ 270-40. Authority to remove and impound.

The Township shall have authority to remove and impound or to order the removal and impounding of any vehicle parked overtime or otherwise illegally, provided that the circumstances of its parking were within the conditions stated in § 270-38 of this Article and can provide that no such vehicle shall be removed or impounded except in strict adherence to the provisions of this Article.

§ 270-41. Designation of approved storage garages; bonding; towing and storage.

Removal and impounding of vehicles under this Article shall be done only by approved storage garages that shall be designed from time-to-time by the Board of Commissioners that are bonded or have acquired liability insurance in an amount satisfactory to the Board of Commissioners as sufficient to indemnify owners of impounded vehicles against loss or damage to those vehicles while in the custody of the garage keeper for the purpose of towing or storage.

§ 270-42. Notification of removal and impounding.

Within 12 hours from the time of removal of any vehicle under authority granted by this Article, notice of the fact that the vehicle was removed shall be sent by the Township to the owner of record of the vehicle. The notice shall designate the place from which the vehicle was removed, the reason for its removal and impounding and the garage in which it was impounded.

§ 270-43. Effect of payment of towing and storage fees.

The payment of any towing and storage charges authorized by this Article shall, unless payment is made under protest, be final and conclusive and shall constitute a waiver of any right to recover the money so paid. If payment of any towing or storage charges is made under protest, the offender shall be entitled to a hearing before a District Justice. Payment of towing and storage charges shall not relieve the owner or driver of any vehicle from liability for any fine or penalty for the violation of the provision of this Chapter for which the vehicle was removed or impounded.

§ 270-44. Records of vehicles removed and impounded.

The Township shall cause a record to be kept of all vehicles impounded under this Article and shall be able at all reasonable times to furnish the owners or the agents of the owners of those vehicles with information as to the place of storage of the vehicle.

§ 270-45. Restrictions upon removal of vehicles.

No vehicle shall be removed under the authority of this Article if, at the time of the intended removal, the owner or the person for the time being in charge of the vehicle is present and expresses a willingness and intention to remove the vehicle immediately.

**ARTICLE V
SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCIES**

§ 270-46. Declaration of snow and ice emergency.

In order to facilitate the movement of traffic and to combat the hazards of snow and ice on the snow emergency routes named pursuant to this Article, the Police Superintendent, in his discretion, may declare a snow and ice emergency (designated in this Article as a “snow emergency”). Information on the existence of a snow emergency may be given by the Township through radio, newspaper or other available media, and information on the termination of the emergency may be given by use of the same media.

§ 270-47. Parking and driving restrictions.

After any snow emergency is declared, it shall be unlawful, at any time during the continuance of the emergency, for any person:

- A. To park a motor vehicle or to allow that vehicle to remain parked anywhere on a snow emergency route designated pursuant to this Article; or
- B. To drive any motor vehicle on any such snow emergency route unless that vehicle is equipped with snow tires or chains.

§ 270-48. Snow emergency routes.

The streets or parts of streets described below are hereby designated as snow emergency routes.

§ 270-49. Snow emergency violations and penalties.

- A. If, at any time during a period of snow emergency declared under this Article, a person shall park a motor vehicle or allow a motor vehicle to remain parked anywhere upon a snow emergency route, that person shall be guilty of a violation of this Article and, upon conviction, shall be punishable as provided in § 270-37 of this Chapter.
- B. If, at any time during a period of snow emergency declared under this Article, a person shall drive a motor vehicle upon a snow emergency route without having that vehicle equipped with snow tires or chains, that person shall be guilty of a violation of this Article, and, upon conviction, shall be punishable as provided in § 270-58 of this Chapter.

**ARTICLE VI
PARKING METERS**

§ 270-50. Designation of parking spaces.

The Police Department is hereby authorized to provide for the marking off of individual parking spaces in the parking zones designated and described in § 270-56, said parking spaces to be designated by lines painted or marked on the curbing or surface of the highway. At each space so marked off, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle in such a way that said vehicle shall not be entirely within the limits of the space so designated.

§ 270-51. Operation of meters.

When any vehicle shall be parked in any space adjacent to which a parking meter is located in accordance with the provisions of this Article, the operator shall, upon entering the said parking space, immediately deposit or cause to be deposited such coin or coins of the United States as is required for such parking meter and as designated by proper instructions on the parking meter, and failure to deposit such coin or coins shall constitute a breach of this Article and shall subject each person to the penalty prescribed in § 270-58 hereof. Upon the deposit of such coin or coins and placing said meter in operation, the parking space may be lawfully occupied by such vehicle during the period of parking time which has been prescribed for the part of the highway in which said parking space is located, and for which a coin or coins is or are deposited, as indicated, on the parking meter. If said vehicle shall remain parked in any such parking space beyond the parking time limit so fixed for such parking space, the parking meter shall, by its violation signal, dial or pointer, indicate such illegal parking, and in that event, such vehicle shall be considered as parked overtime and beyond the period of legal parking time. The parking of a vehicle overtime or beyond the period of legal parking time in any such part of a highway where any such parking meter is located shall be a violation of this Article and punishable as hereinafter set forth.

§ 270-52. Manner of parking.

- A. When a parking space in any parking meter zone is parallel with the adjacent curb or sidewalk, any vehicle parked in such parking space shall be parked so that the foremost part of such vehicle shall be nearest to the parking meter, provided, however, that where double parking meters are installed upon one standard so as to serve as two parking spaces, any vehicle parked in the space just beyond the parking meters shall be parked so that the rear bumper of such vehicle shall be nearest to the parking meter. When a parking space in any parking meter zone is diagonal to the curb or sidewalk, any vehicle parked in such parking space shall be parked with the foremost part of such vehicle nearest to such meter.
- B. Where lines or markings are painted or placed upon the curb, sidewalk, highway and/or paved surface adjacent to each parking meter providing for parking at an angle and not parallel or perpendicular to the curb, it shall be unlawful for the operator of any motor vehicle to cross the center line of the highway to enter or leave said parking area.

§ 270-53. Violations.

It shall be unlawful and a violation of the provisions of this Article for any person:

- A. To cause, allow, permit, or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or operated by such person to be parked overtime or beyond the period of legal parking time established for any parking meter zone as herein described, or to deposit in any parking meter any coin for the purpose of parking beyond the maximum legal parking time for the particular parking meter zone.
- B. To permit any vehicle to remain or be placed in any parking space adjacent to any parking meter while said meter is displaying a signal indicating that the vehicle occupying such parking space has already been parked beyond the period prescribed for such parking space.
- C. To park any vehicle across any line or marking of a parking meter space or in such a position that the vehicle shall not be entirely within the area designated by such lines or markings.
- D. To deface, injure, tamper with, open or willfully break, destroy or impair the usefulness of any parking meter installed under the provisions of this Article.
- E. To deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter any slug, device or metal substance or other substitute for lawful coins.
- F. To park or permit the parking of any vehicle in any parking meter space where the meter does not register lawful parking.

§ 270-54. Report of violations; citations.

It shall be the duty of police officers of the Township of Radnor, and such other persons as may be designated and authorized by the Superintendent of Police, acting in accordance with instructions issued by the Superintendent of Police, to report:

- A. The number of each parking meter which indicates that the vehicle occupying the parking space and adjacent to such parking meter is or has been parked in violation of any of the provisions of this Article.
- B. The state license number of such vehicle.
- C. The length of time during which such vehicle is parked in violation of any provisions of this Article at the time of his inspection.
- D. Any other facts, a knowledge of which is necessary to obtain a thorough understanding of the circumstances attending such violation.

§ 270-55. Collection of coins from meters.

It shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Police to designate some proper person or persons to make regular collections of the moneys deposited in said meters.

§ 270-56. Suspension of provisions; erection of signs; tokens.

- A. Temporary suspension of provisions. The provisions of this Article may be temporarily suspended by the Township Manager, and he may prescribe temporarily such other rules and regulations as traffic conditions may require.
- B. Suspension of provisions on designated holidays. The use of parking meters throughout the Township of Radnor be and the same is dispensed with on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.
- C. Erection of signs. The Superintendent of Police is authorized to erect or cause to be erected appropriate signs notifying the operators of motor vehicles of the provisions of this Section of this Article.
- D. Tokens. Where the use of coin or coins is required under the provisions of this Article, it shall be permissible to use such token for that use as shall be designated and approved by the Township.

§ 270-57. Parking meter zones established.

- A. Parking meter zones are hereby established upon the highway or parts of highways described below, and parking or standing a vehicle in any parking meter space in such zones shall be lawful only upon deposit of the amount required for each specified period

of time and only when not in excess of the maximum parking time indicated, on all days except Sunday and Holidays. Hours in operation shall be 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.

§ 270-58. Parking meter rates.

The charges for the zones established above shall be as follows:

- A. In parking meter spaces with a time limit of 15 minutes, the charge shall be \$0.25 in the form of \$0.25 for 15 minutes maximum.
- B. In parking meter spaces with a time limit of two hours, the charge shall be \$0.25 in the form of \$0.25 for each 30 minutes for two hours maximum.
- C. In parking meter spaces with a time limit of five hours, the charge shall be \$0.25 in the form of \$0.25 for each 30 minutes for five hours maximum.
- D. In parking meter spaces with a time limit of ten hours, the charge shall be \$0.25 in the form of \$0.25 for each 30 minutes for ten hours maximum.
- E. In parking meter spaces with a time limit of 30 minutes, the charge shall be \$0.25 in the form of \$0.25 for 30 minutes maximum.

**ARTICLE VII
PEDESTRIAN REGULATIONS**

§ 270-59. Pedestrians to obey traffic control signs.

At all locations in the Township where official traffic control signals are installed, pedestrians, except where directed otherwise by pedestrian-control signals installed under § 270-59, shall obey the directions of those traffic control signals, as follows:

- A. Location:
 - 1) Conestoga Road at Garrett Avenue/Williams Road, east and west;

- 2) Garrett Avenue at Conestoga Road;
- 3) Williams Road at Conestoga Road;
- 4) East Lancaster Avenue at County Line Road;
- 5) County Line Road at East Lancaster Avenue;
- 6) Haverford Road at Landover Road;
- 7) Sproul Road at Clyde Road;
- 8) King of Prussia Road at Matsonford Road;
- 9) Matsonford Road at South Centennial Drive;
- 10) North Wayne Avenue at West Avenue/Station Road;
- 11) North Wayne Avenue at Poplar Avenue; and
- 12) 150 Radnor Chester Road.

B. When facing a green signal, a pedestrian may proceed across the roadway within a crosswalk.

C. When facing a steady yellow signal, a pedestrian shall not start to cross the roadway.

D. When facing a steady red signal, a pedestrian shall not enter the roadway.

§ 270-60. Pedestrian-control signal locations established.

A. At the following locations, official pedestrian-control signals shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected):

- 1) East Lancaster Avenue at Lowry's Lane;
- 2) Lowry's Lane at East Lancaster Avenue;
- 3) East Lancaster Avenue at Airdale Road;
- 4) Airdale Road at East Lancaster Avenue;
- 5) County Line Road at Lindsay Avenue;
- 6) Glenbrook Avenue at County Line Road;
- 7) Glenbrook Avenue at Conestoga Road;
- 8) County Line Road at Glenbrook Avenue;
- 9) Bryn Mawr Avenue at County Line Road;
- 10) County Line Road at Bryn Mawr Avenue, north and south;
- 11) East Lancaster Avenue at North Ithan Avenue/South Ithan Avenue, east and west;
- 12) South Ithan Avenue at East Lancaster Avenue;
- 13) North Ithan Avenue at East Lancaster Avenue;
- 14) East Lancaster Avenue at Villanova Chapel, east and west;
- 15) North Spring Mill Road at East Lancaster Avenue;
- 16) East Lancaster Avenue at North Spring Mill Road/Aldwyn Lane;
- 17) Kenilworth Road at East Lancaster Avenue;
- 18) Aldwyn Lane at East Lancaster Avenue;
- 19) East Lancaster Avenue at Radnor Chester Road;
- 20) 550/555 East Lancaster Avenue, east;
- 21) East Lancaster Avenue at Chamounix Road/St. Davids Road;
- 22) East Lancaster Avenue at South Aberdeen Avenue/North Aberdeen Avenue;
- 23) East Lancaster Avenue at Louella Avenue;

- 24) Lancaster Avenue at South Wayne Avenue/North Wayne Avenue;
- 25) Sugartown Road at Morris Road;
- 26) Conestoga Road at West Wayne Avenue;
- 27) East Lancaster Avenue at King of Prussia Road;
- 28) King of Prussia Road at Radnor Chester Road;
- 29) West Lancaster Avenue at Old Eagle School Road/Sugartown Road;
- 30) West Lancaster Avenue at Conestoga Road/Eagle Road;
- 31) West Lancaster Avenue at Banbury Way/Bloomingdale Avenue; and
- 32) East Lancaster Avenue at Hillside Road.

B. Every pedestrian facing a steady or flashing “Upraised Hand” symbol shall obey the directions of that signal, as follows:

- 1) When facing a steady “Upraised Hand” symbol, a pedestrian shall not start to cross the roadway in the direction of the signal, but any pedestrian who has partially completed his crossing on the “Walking Person” symbol should proceed to a sidewalk or safety zone while the “Upraised Hand” symbol is showing.
- 2) When facing a flashing “Upraised Hand” symbol, a pedestrian shall not start to cross the roadway in the direction of the indication, but any pedestrian who has partly completed crossing during the “Walking Person” symbol should proceed to a sidewalk or safety zone.

C. Any pedestrian who fails to obey the directions of an “Upraised Hand” symbol as indicated above, shall be guilty of an offense and a violation of this Article.

§ 270-61. Locations where pedestrian crossing in unmarked crosswalks restricted.

Except when authorized by a police officer or other appropriately attired person authorized to direct, control or regulate traffic, it shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to cross the roadway at any of the following streets, at the intersection with that street indicated:

- 1) Conestoga Road at Sproul Road;
- 2) Bryn Mawr Avenue at Mailin Road;
- 3) Lancaster Avenue at Kenilworth Road;
- 4) Lancaster Avenue at Villanova Center;
- 5) Sproul Road at East Lancaster Avenue;
- 6) King of Prussia Road at Eagle Road/Pine Tree Road;
- 7) North Wayne Avenue at Eagle Road; and
- 8) Eagle Road at Radnor Street Road.

§ 270-62. Locations where pedestrians may cross only in crosswalk.

It shall be unlawful for any pedestrian:

- A. To cross any roadway in a business district within the Township, except in a crosswalk.

B. To cross the roadway in any of the following portions of streets in the Township, except in a crosswalk:

- 1) Williams Road at Conestoga Road;
- 2) Rockingham Road at Dreer Lane;
- 3) Conestoga Road at Rockingham Road/Good Shepherd Terrace, east and west;
- 4) Conestoga Road at Meredith Avenue/Bailey Road, east and west;
- 5) Conestoga Road at Summit Terrace;
- 6) Conestoga Road at Macrone Park, east and west;
- 7) Landover Road at Coopertown Road;
- 8) Cooper Road at Landover Road;
- 9) North Ithan Avenue at Villanova University Main Gate;
- 10) Clyde Road at Drakes Drum Road/Arbor Place;
- 11) Saw Mill Road at Saw Mill Park Entrance;
- 12) 290 King of Prussia Road;
- 13) King of Prussia Road at Glen Mary Road;
- 14) 1200 Eagle Road;
- 15) 1001 Eagle Road;
- 16) North Wayne Avenue at Walnut Avenue;
- 17) North Aberdeen Avenue at Aberdeen Terrace;
- 18) East Lancaster Avenue at Louella Court;
- 19) Conestoga Road at South Devon Road;
- 20) West Wayne Avenue at Highland Avenue;
- 21) 419 West Wayne Avenue;
- 22) West Wayne Avenue at Dory Lane;
- 23) 60 West Avenue;
- 24) West Wayne Avenue at Donna Lane;
- 25) West Wayne Avenue at Arbordale Road;
- 26) West Wayne Avenue at Crestview Road;
- 27) Radnor Chester Road at Chew Lane;
- 28) Conestoga Road at Brookside Avenue;
- 29) South Wayne Avenue at Windermere Avenue;
- 30) South Wayne Avenue at Runnymere Avenue;
- 31) South Wayne Avenue at West Wayne Avenue;
- 32) South Wayne Avenue at School Lane;
- 33) West Wayne Avenue at Bloomingdale Avenue;
- 34) Louella Avenue at Windermere Avenue;
- 35) Louella Avenue at Midland Avenue;
- 36) Louella Avenue at School Lane;
- 37) South Aberdeen Avenue at Midland Avenue; and
- 38) South Aberdeen Avenue at St. Davids Road/Windermere Avenue.

§ 270-63. Penalty for violation.

Any pedestrian who violates any provision of this Article shall be guilty of a summary offense and, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$5.00, plus costs.

**ARTICLE VIII
TRAFFIC CALMING SYSTEMS**

§ 270-64. Intent.

The purpose of this Policy is to establish guidelines for the installation of traffic calming systems on Township-owned roadways. Such systems shall be specifically designed to reduce the speed, but not necessarily the volume of motor vehicle traffic in residential areas, nor is their purpose to move traffic to adjoining roadways. Traffic calming measures shall also consist of enforcement and education activities by the Police Department.

§ 270-65. Definition.

For the purpose of this Chapter, except as may otherwise be determined under §270-68.M. herein “speed hump” shall be synonymous with “traffic calming system” or “traffic calming measure.” A speed hump shall be a raised hump in the pavement extending across the width of the roadway at a right angle to the direction of the flow of traffic.

§ 270-66. Policy.

It is the policy of the Township to install speed humps on streets in accordance with the procedures and criteria listed in §§ 270-67 and 270-68 herein.

§ 270-67. Procedure.

Applicants may request that a study be conducted to construct speed humps in a particular neighborhood. Requests shall be submitted in writing along with a petition described below to the Superintendent of Police for consideration at the next available meeting of the Staff Traffic Committee (the “Committee”). Such requests shall be submitted a minimum of 30 days before the Committee meeting at which they will be discussed.

A. Petition.

- 1) All adult residents of the affected streets, pursuant to Subsection A.2) below, must be contacted by the applicants and advised that speed humps are being considered for their street.
- 2) A signed petition must be submitted reflecting the support of a minimum of 80% of the residents of households on the street on which humps are proposed to be installed and a minimum of 60% of the residents of households located on streets or cul-de-sacs whose only access is via the street on which humps are proposed to be installed.
- 3) Only one adult signature per household, apartment, or business will be considered on the petition.

§ 270-68. Criteria.

The following criteria shall be used to limit speed humps to areas where they will be most effective and practical:

- A. Speed humps will not be installed on State highways.
- B. The legally posted speed limit on the street shall not exceed 25 miles per hour (mph).
- C. The average daily traffic (ADT) shall not be less than 1,000 vehicles per day which shall be determined by a seven-day automated traffic count conducted by the Department's Traffic Safety Unit. Manual counts may be instituted at the Department's discretion.
- D. The average vehicle speed (based upon the 85th percentile of the speeds recorded during the traffic count) shall not be less than 10 mph over the legally posted speed limit, which shall be determined by a seven-day automated traffic count.
- E. The Department will analyze the number of accidents on the affected roadway over the most recent three-year period to ascertain the extent to which excessive or unsafe speeds were a major contributing factor.
- F. The distance between speed humps shall not be less than 250 or greater than 600 feet apart; provided, however, that should an intersection controlled by a stop sign or yield sign be located on the affected roadway, the distance between humps may exceed 600 feet. The existing stop sign or yield sign may be reevaluated to see if it continues to meet the warrants of the State of Pennsylvania after the installation of humps.
- G. Speed humps shall not be less than 150 feet from an intersecting roadway or within 250 feet of a signalized intersection.
- H. Speed humps shall not be installed on hills or curves that could affect the safe control of vehicles.
- J. Speed humps shall traverse the entire roadway allowing one foot on each side for the flow of stormwater.
- K. Speed humps shall be no less than 12 feet in width.
- L. Signs indicating HUMP shall be erected in each direction at the location of the hump and a sufficient distance before the hump to warn approaching motorists. For increased visibility, reflective stripes shall be painted on the humps.
- M. Other traffic calming measures:

- 1) Notwithstanding whether or not a petition has been submitted under § 270-67, nothing herein shall limit the Township's right to unilaterally consider and install any traffic calming measures whatsoever, including, but not limited to, speed humps, bulb outs, chicanes, raised crosswalks, etc., as it may deem necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of a specific neighborhood or the public in general.
 - 2) This Section shall apply to any street within the Township, especially streets where the Township determines there is a high concentration of pedestrian and vehicular traffic such as those near schools, parks and recreation areas, churches and business districts.
 - 3) The Township shall notify the residents and businesses on any streets for which such traffic calming measures are being considered to permit their input before such measures are approved and installed.
- N. Speeding. When speeding is the primary concern, the 85th percentile speed (or average speed) shall exceed 10 mph over the posted speed limit before traffic calming is considered.
- 1) 85th percentile speed. The 85th percentile speed is the speed at or below which 85% of the motorists on a street are traveling. This speed is often used as a measure of the upper limit of reasonable speeds for prevailing conditions.
 - 2) Average speed shall be used only when the number of vehicles necessary for determining the 85th percentile speed cannot reasonably be obtained.

§ 270-69. Approval and installation.

- A. All decisions regarding whether or not to recommend the installation of speed humps shall be made by the Committee in accordance with the criteria contained herein.
- B. All Committee recommendations to install speed humps in the petitioned area shall be subject to final approval by the Board.

Section 2.

Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3.

Severability. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

Section 4.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the Home Rule Charter of Radnor Township.
