

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RADNOR, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 130-9 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RADNOR, "VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC CODE", IN REGARD TO ONE-WAY HIGHWAYS ON SCHOOL LANE.

Section I. That Section 130-9 of the Code of the Township of Radnor be amended as follows:

The following are hereby established One-Way Highways.

<u>Name of Highway</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>	<u>Location</u>
School Lane	West	Entire length in a westerly direction from Louella Avenue to South Wayne Avenue

Section II. The authorization under this Ordinance to establish School Lane as a one-way highway shall expire on April 30, 2010.

Section III. Severability. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

Section IV. Repealer. All ordinance or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section VI. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the Radnor Township Home Rule Charter.
