

RESOLUTION 2021-32

A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING THE RENEWABLE ENERGY AND CONSERVATION PLAN DATED FEBRUARY 2021 PREPARED BY PRACTICAL ENERGY SOLUTIONS AND ASSIGNING IMPLEMENTATION TO THE TOWNSHIP'S GREEN TEAM TO DEVELOP PRIORITIES AND REPORT BACK TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

**WHEREAS**, In February 2019, the Board of Commissions adopted Resolution 2019-08, titled, "A Vision For A 100% Clean Renewable Energy Future," committing to 100% clean renewable electricity by 2035 and 100% clean energy by 2050; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 2019-08 engaged Practical Energy Solutions to work with the Radnor Green Team to create the Renewable Energy and Conservation Plan to identify and compile strategies that would progressively impact Radnor's clean energy goals; and

**WHEREAS**, Practical Energy Solutions completed the report in February 2021, which can be found on the Radnor Township website ([www.radnor.com](http://www.radnor.com)); and

**WHEREAS**, Practical Energy Solutions presented the report's findings and recommendations on March 2, 2021 and a link of the recorded meeting can be found on the Radnor Township website ([www.radnor.com](http://www.radnor.com)); and


**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners is assigning the Green Team the task of working with the Township Administration to develop priority elements of the Plan over time, make necessary recommendations, and request resources of the Board of Commissioners as needed.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners adopts Practical Energy Solution's Renewable Energy and Conservation Plan dated February 2021, and assigns the task of developing priority elements, making recommendations, and requesting Township resources as necessary to the Green Team, in coordination with the Township Administration.


