

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-127

A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA'S REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE CAPITAL PROGRAM FOR THE SOUTH WAYNE MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT FLOOD REDUCTION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the South Wayne neighborhood of Radnor Township ("Township") experiences nuisance and severe community flooding; and

WHEREAS, the Radnor Fire Company could be hindered in its ability to provide fire and ambulance services due to the flooding in front of the fire house on South Wayne Avenue; and

WHEREAS, public health and safety is a concern due to flooded roads and the inability of emergency vehicles to access certain areas; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to request a Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) grant of \$1,025,000 from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Office of Budget to be used to construct a stormwater conveyance system and subsurface stormwater storage system under the South Wayne Parking Lot and commits to a matching component for the grant in an amount not to exceed \$2,200,000 and authorizes the Township Manager to execute all required documentation related this grant application with the Office of Budget.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby RESOLVED that the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners authorizes a Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) grant application from the Office of Budget in the amount of \$1,025,000 and Township matching funds up to \$2,200,000 to be used for the development of stormwater conveyance system and a subsurface stormwater storage system under the South Wayne Parking Lot.


