A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, AUTHORIZING GANNETT FLEMING TO PERFORM A PRELIMINARY FEASIBILITY STUDY OF THE ROBINHOOD ROAD CULVERT OUTFALL PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,200.

WHEREAS, the Robinhood Road Outfall is impacting the bank of 790 Robinhood Road

WHEREAS, the gabion baskets installed as part of a previous Township project are deteriorating, and upon further deterioration, will affect the dwelling at 790 Robinhood Road

WHEREAS, slightly further downstream, the stream bank has eroded to the point where further erosion may affect the foundation of the dwelling at 790 Robinhood Road


WHEREAS, Gannett Fleming, Incorporated, has provided a cost proposal to evaluate the stream bank erosion and threat to the dwelling at 790 Robinhood Road, and will provide possible solutions and high level cost estimates

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township does hereby Authorize Gannett Fleming to Perform a Preliminary Feasibility Study of the Robinhood Road Culvert Outfall Project in the Amount of \$7,200.


