

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-36

**A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING A THREE-YEAR RENEWAL FOR THE
WARRANTY ON THE DELL SERVER EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, The Township Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution 2016-42, authorizing the purchase and installation of a new server to house the Township's operating software and data; and

WHEREAS, to ensure uninterrupted server operations, the Township purchased Dell's three-year warranty program that promises four-hour on-site service for mission critical server equipment; and

WHEREAS, the term of the initial warranty program is expiring, and the Township wishes to renew the warranty and continue the coverage for all mission critical server equipment for another three years; and

WHEREAS, all departmental data and operational software lives on the servers being covered by the warranty, including the Township's Police Department, which makes it critical that the equipment be serviced and fixed within a four-hour window to ensure no lapse in operations; and


WHEREAS, the Township's network administration company, Alura, has provided a quote to purchase the warranty and will execute the service in the event that the covered server equipment fails at a price of \$21,374.02.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby *RESOLVED* that the Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township does hereby authorize the renewal of the Dell warranty for the Township's server equipment at a quoted price of \$21,374.02 for the period May 1, 2019 through May 1, 2022; noting that the price quoted covers the entire term of the warranty.
