WHERAS, the municipal elections for Commissioners are held every two years, resulting in up to four new elected officials representing the township in each instance; and

WHERAS, the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners (the "Board") is subject to the requirements of the Pennsylvania Sunshine Act (Open Meetings Law) and Open Records Act, among others; and

WHERAS, it is the policy of the Board that each Commissioner is encouraged to attend regular training sessions with respect to the Pennsylvania Sunshine Act (Open Meetings Law) and Open Records Act, among others, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, as well as to provide access to such training to the public, whenever possible.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Radnor Township Administration shall facilitate access to, schedule sessions with, or otherwise make available to all Commissioners, training on the Sunshine Act and Open Records Act by an agreed upon agency, such as the Open Records Office in Harrisburg, PA.
- The Radnor Township Administration shall facilitate access to, schedule sessions with, or
 otherwise make available to all Commissioners, training on the Sunshine Act and Open
 Records Act at least every two years, within 60 days following the swearing-in of a new
 Board of Commissioners.
- 3. The Board does hereby direct the Radnor Township Administration to make such training sessions available to all boards and commissions, as well as invite members of the community to attend.
