A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE EMERGENCY GRINDING OF BRUSH AT SKUNK HOLLOW PARK TO MAYFIELD GARDENS

WHEREAS, the Township collects residential yard waste each week, which is taken to Skunk Hollow and ground into mulch and wood chips

WHEREAS, the Township's tub grinder was severely damaged in a fire

WHEREAS, the accumulation of tree storm debris and yard waste has accumulated to an unsafe and unmanageable level

WHEREAS, Mayfield Gardens has a grinder, and can grind up this accumulated debris and has submitted a daily rate to grind at \$4,500 per day

WHEREAS, it has been determined that two days of grinding would be required to make the area manageable

NOW, THEREFORE, be it *RESOLVED* the Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township does hereby award the emergency grinding of debris at Skunk Hollow, to Mayfield Gardens, in the amount of \$9,000
