RESOLUTION NO. 2014-58

A RESOLUTION OF THE RADNOR TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO IMPROVE AND EXPAND THE MEMORIAL LIBRARY OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP SO THAT THE COMMUNITY WILL HAVE A LIBRARY FACILITY TO BETTER MEET COMMUNITY NEEDS, ENHANCE LIBRARY SERVICES TO RADNOR RESIDENTS AND PROVIDE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS WITH OPPORTUNITIES TO EXPLORE IDEAS AND INTERACT WITH EACH OTHER, THUS STRENGTHENING OUR COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, the Memorial Library of Radnor Township has been an integral part of the village of Wayne since 1892; and

WHEREAS, the Memorial Library of Radnor Township serves all residents of the township regardless of age, race gender or income; and

WHEREAS, the Memorial Library of Radnor Township is an extremely popular and heavily used facility supported with township funds through its annual contribution; and

WHEREAS, the current library building at 114 West Wayne Avenue has been in operation since 1980 without significant change or upgrading; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is committed to the library remaining at its current location in Wayne; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township recognizes the value of the services provided by the library to members of the community and the contribution of the library to the quality of life of township residents; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is partnering with the library to apply for state funding to assist with the upgrading of the library.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby **RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners supports the library in its efforts to raise at least \$1 million to renovate, update and expand the library located at 114 West Wayne Avenue to better serve Radnor residents now and in the future.
