

RESOLUTION 2012-29

A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO CREATE A NEW U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE EQUITABLE SHARING PROGRAM (ESP) SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (#14)

WHEREAS, the Radnor Township Police Department has recently enrolled in the U.S. Department of Justice Equitable Sharing Program which allows the Township to partner with the U.S. Department of Justice in the distribution of an equitable share of forfeited property and proceeds resulting from joint enforcement efforts; and

WHEREAS, In order to receive the Township's equitable share of any proceeds, the Township must certify our intentions to adhere to the Equitable Sharing Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Compliance with the Equitable Sharing Agreement requires that the Township establish a separate special revenue fund to account for all accounting and reporting of the proceeds, expenditures and other matters related to the Township's participation in the program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wishes to comply with the Equitable Sharing Agreement by establishing a new U.S. Department of Justice Equitable Sharing Program (ESP) Special Revenue Fund (#14).

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby *RESOLVED* by the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners authorize the Administration to create Fund #14 titled, US Department of Justice Equitable Sharing Program (ESP) within the Township's financial accounting system and to establish the appropriate bank accounts and controls necessary to comply with the Equitable Sharing Agreement.
