

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-62

A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY AGREEMENTS TO PROCEED WITH EMERGENCY REPAIRS FOR THE SAFETY OF LIFE, HEALTH, AND PROPERTY OF THE RESIDENTS OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, on Conestoga Road, a minimum of sixty linear feet of sanitary sewer line has failed and must be replaced

WHEREAS, on Lancaster Avenue, one manhole, in imminent danger of failure, must be rebuilt

WHEREAS, on Runnymede Avenue, a minimum of seventy linear feet of sanitary sewer has failed and must be replaced

WHEREAS, on Barley Cone Lane, a minimum of one hundred and seventy linear feet of storm sewer has failed and must be replaced

WHEREAS, at the intersection of Louella Avenue and Lancaster Avenue a traffic signal, no longer functions properly and must be repaired


WHEREAS, at the Willows Park, a minimum of one hundred linear feet of water line has failed, and must be replaced

WHEREAS, at the North Wayne Field, an existing stormwater management facility has failed and must be repaired immediately


