**RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR COMMENCEMENT OF FEASIBILITY STUDY
FOR CONSTRUCTION OF MULTI-PURPOSE TRAIL WITHIN THE SEPTA ROUTE
100 RIGHT-OF-WAY AND AUTHORIZATION OF TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATION
TO BEGIN DISCUSSIONS WITH INTERESTED PARTIES REGARDING THE
FEASIBILITY OF SUCH A TRAIL**

WHEREAS, the right-of-way within which the SEPTA Route 100 trolley line ("Route 100") is located is wide enough to support four tracks (the "ROW"); and


WHEREAS, only two tracks were laid within one-half of the ROW; and


WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Radnor Township desire to authorize the Township Administration to begin preliminary discussions with all interested parties for the purpose of determining the feasibility of constructing a multi-purpose trail within the other half of the ROW not occupied by the Route 100 trolley tracks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to begin discussions with all interested parties such as Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority, Delaware County, all townships through which the ROW passes and potential funding sources for the purpose of determining the feasibility of constructing a multi-purpose trail within the existing ROW; provided, however, that nothing in this resolution shall be construed as authorizing the Township Manager to spend funds outside his pre-approved authority or to enter into any agreements binding on the Township without further authorization from the Board of Commissioners.
