A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A BID FOR DE-ICING SALT FOR THE 2010/2011 WINTER SEASON FOR TOWNSHIP ROADWAYS FROM FUNDS ALLOCATED IN THE 2010 SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL OPERATING SUPPLIES ACCOUNT

*WHEREAS*, Radnor Township requests and receives bids on an annual basis with a consortium of twelve (12) municipalities for the purchase of de-icing salt in order to maintain a high level of traffic safety along township roads; and

*WHEREAS*, the Township has duly advertised the request for salt bids for the 2010/2011 winter season; and


