  - a.25 Food Inspections

  - c. 03 Quality of Life Issues
    - i. 1 Bat in the house = test negative for rubies
    - ii. 1 Mold in dwelling = Mgt. correct problem and offered a new apt.
  - iii. 1 issue with commercial swimming pool water too cold. Twp. Regulations requires no hotter than 104f however does not regulate the cold temperature

  - i. Chicken manure is safe to use as compost
  - ii. Chickens need outdoor space to move about
  - iii. Four chickens is better than three

construction company has no legal requirement to monitor particulate air quality. Recommendation was made to stay on top of the issue and/or continue to attend Villanova CARES meetings.
