12 Meadowood Road Construct an addition, walks, and patio 90 CY of dirt (keep on site) Remove (2) 18" Pine Trees Conditional Approval

Applicant was asked to consider planting a shade tree even though it is not required Show tree protection fence around all trees within 25' of construction Show limit of disturbance
Revise plans and submit to Engineering

682 Conestoga Road Construct single family dwelling 550 CY of dirt (take off site)

(6) trees to be removed

(2) 6-18" (1) 19-29" (3) > 30"

23 trees to be provided 14 being large canopy

Applicant wishes to post some funds in big tree fund in lieu of some of the plantings Some trees will be planted on site for purpose of creating buffers Pull tree protection further away from trunk of 31" Poplar Township Arborist will discuss with applicant to ensure all requirements are met Submit landscape plan to Engineering for Township Arborist to review

800 Goshen Road Preliminary SALDO Application 2016-S-08 Subdivide existing parcel into (3) residential lots 69 trees to be remove 114 trees to be provided

Applicant will return to Shade Tree when plan is in the *Final Submission*Applicant will have to return with grading permit applications for each lot if approved Applicant was asked to supply larger dbh trees as replacement than what the code requires Applicant was asked to supply an overlay plan showing new trees in and old trees out It was requested that buffering trees be added along Goshen Road It was requested that extra trees be donated to Clem Macrone and Fenimore Parks

## Hazardous Tree Removals Approved for removal by Township Arborist

137 Eaton Drive

32" Tulip Poplar

Dieback in crown, rot and decay present, fungus growing at base, close proximity to two residences

322 Edgehill Road

Requested a tree be planted

50" Red Oak

Hazardous dead limbs and considerable tip die back in upper canopy

Cabrini College

610 King of Prussia Road

(2) 10" Maachia Trees close to construction

30" White Pine dying at top and infested with pine borer

40 Aldwyn Lane Several trees will be planted

36" Red Maple

Lean towards neighbor's property, severe defect towards base from a previous lead failure, last week's storm created new broken limbs in the crown
