## **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Kristin Burton of South Devon Avenue requests that pedestrian concerns on South Devon at Liberty Lane be addressed.

Highway Patrol conducted a 5-year crash history resulting in no crashes at this intersection. A sight survey conducted by Highway Patrol Officers revealed an asphalt walk on Liberty Lane at S. Devon Avenue and private driveway aprons on the west side of S. Devon Avenue. The asphalt walk at the intersection of S. Devon Avenue is not ADA compliant nor are the driveway aprons. The Staff Traffic Committee does not recommend that a crosswalk be installed at this location.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

2. Request from Bryn Mawr Fire Company for one side of street parking in the Conestoga Village area of Ward 7.

The Staff Traffic Committee recommends that Temporary No Parking Signs be installed on the west side of Barcladen Road, Barcladen Circle and the north side of Debaron Lane between Lowry's Lane and Barcladen Road. The temporary restrictions will remain in place for a period of 60 days as a trial period. This item will be redressed after the 60 day period.
