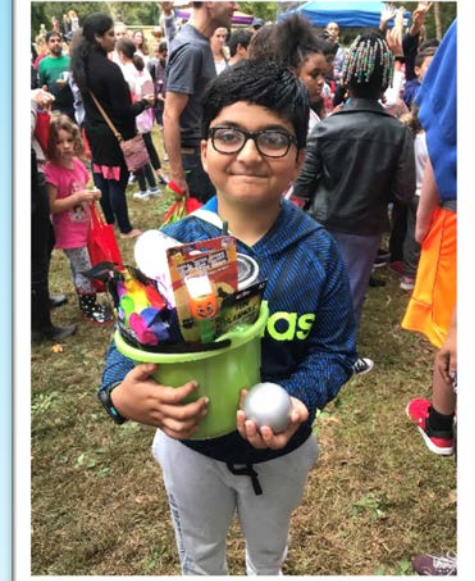
Those who pre-registered for their pumpkin had first choice of the perfect pumpkin!



The Great Pumpkin Patch



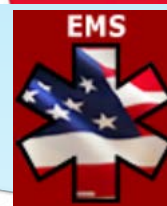
Participants participated in
