TO RECEIVE SEALED BIDS FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF THE VALLEY RUN STREAM BANK STABILIZATION AND
CULVERT EXTENSION PROJECT AT ROBINHOOD ROAD AT AN
ESTILATED CONSTRUCTION COST OF \$450,000
TO BE FUNDED FROM THE STORMWATER FUND

WHEREAS, Radnor Township addressed the emergency condition at the Valley Run stream bank at 790 Robinhood Road;

WHEREAS, the Township needs to install a permanent solution;

WHEREAS, the permanent solution has been designed and is ready for bid; and

WHEREAS, the improvements will provide the protection needed for the property owners and those adjacent.


