CHARLES A. HIGGINS & SONS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$27,160.00, AND
AT NORTH WAYNE AVENUE AND POPLAR AVENUE TO
ARMOUR & SONS ELECTRIC, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,357.00,
ALL TO BE PAID FROM THE EMERGENCY CONTRACTED SERVICES FUND

WHEREAS, Radnor Township is responsible for the maintenance and repair of the traffic signals within the Township;


WHEREAS, a traffic signal emergency repair was immediately required and prompted an inspection of all traffic signals; and

WHEREAS, at least two other traffic signals were determined to be in need of immediate repair.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it *RESOLVED* by the Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township does hereby Authorize the Payment for: the Emergency Inspection of Traffic Signal Poles to Charles A. Higgins & Sons, Inc. in an Amount Not to Exceed \$26,000.00; and the Emergency Repair of the Traffic Signals at Lancaster Avenue and South Ithan Avenue to Charles A. Higgins & Sons, Inc. in the Amount of \$77,581.40, at Matsonford Road and County Line Road to Charles A. Higgins & Sons, Inc. in the Amount of \$27,160.00, and at North Wayne Avenue and Poplar Avenue to Armour & Sons Electric, Inc. in the Amount of \$11,357.00, All to be Paid from the Emergency Contracted Services Fund
