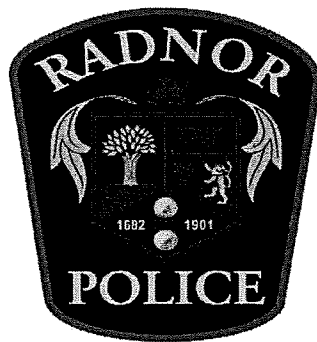

Theft from Vehicle - 200 block of Sugartown Rd.

Post Date:05/04/2022 7:42 AM

Sometime between 7:30 AM on 5/2/2022 and 8:20 AM on 5/3/2022 several items were stolen from a tractor trailer parked in the 200 block of Sugartown Rd. The items were removed from the cab of the truck and the vehicle was left unlocked at the time of the theft.

Suspicious Person - 500 block of Woodland Ct.

On Monday, 5/2/2022, at approximately 11:45 PM, the resident in the 500 block of Woodland Ct. reported that an unknown male was knocking at their front door. The resident reports the subject was a white male, between 50 and 60 years of age, wearing a jacket, blue jeans. He had gray hair and appeared disheveled. When the resident answered the door, the male stated that he had the wrong house and quickly left the area. It is unknown if the male had a vehicle.

Attempted Theft - 550 E. Lancaster Av. - The Giant Store

On Friday, 5/6/2022, at approximately 12:39 PM, the victim observed a female in her purse attempting to remove her wallet, while they were shopping at the Giant Supermarket, located at 550 E. Lancaster Av. The victim stated that a black male with a thin build who walked with a cane engaged her in conversation. While the victim was speaking with the male, she turned and observed a black female, wearing a black coat, with a gray hoodie underneath, and blank pants with her hand in her purse attempting to remove her wallet. When confronted the black female and black male, both left the store together. They were seen entering a gray vehicle and driving out of the parking lot.

Criminal Mischief to Auto - Unit block of Devonwood Rd.

Retail; Theft - Micro Center - 550 E. Lancaster Av.

The store employee reported that a white male, possibly Hispanic, just stole multiple items from the store. The male was last seen fleeing north across Lancaster Av. on foot.

Criminal Mischief - 1000 block of Countyline Rd.

Sometime over night between 5/10/2022 and 5/11/2022, the resident of the 1000 block of Countyline Rd. reports vandalism occurred to their property. The resident reports that their home video camera records an unknown, white male run up onto their porch and forcibly removed an Adirondack chair and damaging it.

Theft from Vehicles - Eachus Av. and Fairfax Rd.

Sometime overnight between 5/10/2022 and 5/11/2022 several vehicles were entered and had items stolen from park vehicles in the area of Eachus Av. and Fairfax Rd. All the vehicles that were entered were left unlocked at the time of the thefts. The vehicles that were entered all had personal property that was taken from them.

Criminal Trespass - 452 S. Roberts Rd. - The Village

Crime Alert - Beware of Recent Scam!

Post Date:05/23/2022 3:56 PM

The Radnor Police along with other neighboring departments have responded to a concerning new scam which has affected several elderly residents. A “grandchild” scam is one that will start with a call from someone pretending to be your grandchild. They might speak softly or make an excuse for why they sound different. They’ll say they’re in trouble, need bail, or need money for some reason. The “grandkid” will also beg you to keep this a secret — maybe they’re “under a gag order,” or they don’t want their parents to know. Sometimes, they might put another scammer on the line who pretends to be a lawyer needing money to represent the grandchild in court.

But, instead of asking you to buy gift cards or wire money (both signs of a scam), the scammer tells you someone will come to your door to pick up cash. Once you hand it over, your money is gone. But you might get more calls to send money by wire transfer or through the mail.

To avoid these scams and protect your personal information:

- Take a breath and resist the pressure to pay. Get off the phone and call or text the person who (supposedly) called. If you can't reach them, check with a family member to get the real story. Even though the scammer said not to.
- Don't give your address, personal information, or cash to anyone who contacts you. And anyone who asks you to pay by gift card or money transfer is a scammer. Always.
- Check your social media privacy settings and limit what you share publicly. Even if your settings are on private, be careful about what personal identifiers you put out on social media.

If experienced this type of scam, whether you gave money or not, it was a crime, call 911 and report this immediately to the Radnor Police.

Crime Alert - Theft of Building Materials

Post Date:05/24/2022 12:30 PM

On 5/23/22, Radnor Police responded to the unit block of Tyler Lane for a theft of building materials. Taken was a bundle of cedar shingles valued at \$172.00. The male actor arrived in a dark grey Chevy Tahoe with large bumper stickers on the right, rear bumper. Anyone with additional information is asked to dial 911 and speak with Radnor Police.

Crime & Police Alerts

Stolen Wallet - 550 E. Lancaster Av. - TJ Maxx Store

Post Date:05/31/2022 7:51 AM

On Monday, 5/30/2022, at approximately 4:03 PM the victim reports their wallet stolen from the TJ Maxx Store. The victim reports that while shopping at the TJ Maxx they left their wallet on the check out counter and left the store. When they return to the store approximately 30 minutes later the wallet was gone and could not be located.

The Radnor Police respects citizens' privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties by emphasizing behavior, rather than appearance, in identifying suspicious activity. Factors such as race, ethnicity, and/or religious affiliation are not suspicious. The public should only report suspicious behavior and situations (e.g., an unattended backpack or package, or someone breaking into a vehicle or restricted area). Moreover, any physical descriptions are based on victim and witness statements provided to the Radnor Police at the time the incident was reported or developed through investigation.

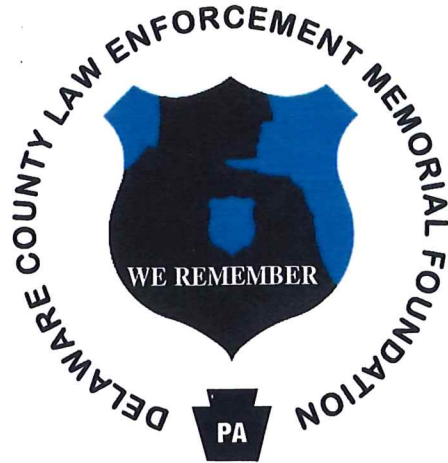
