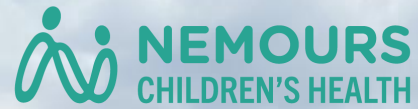

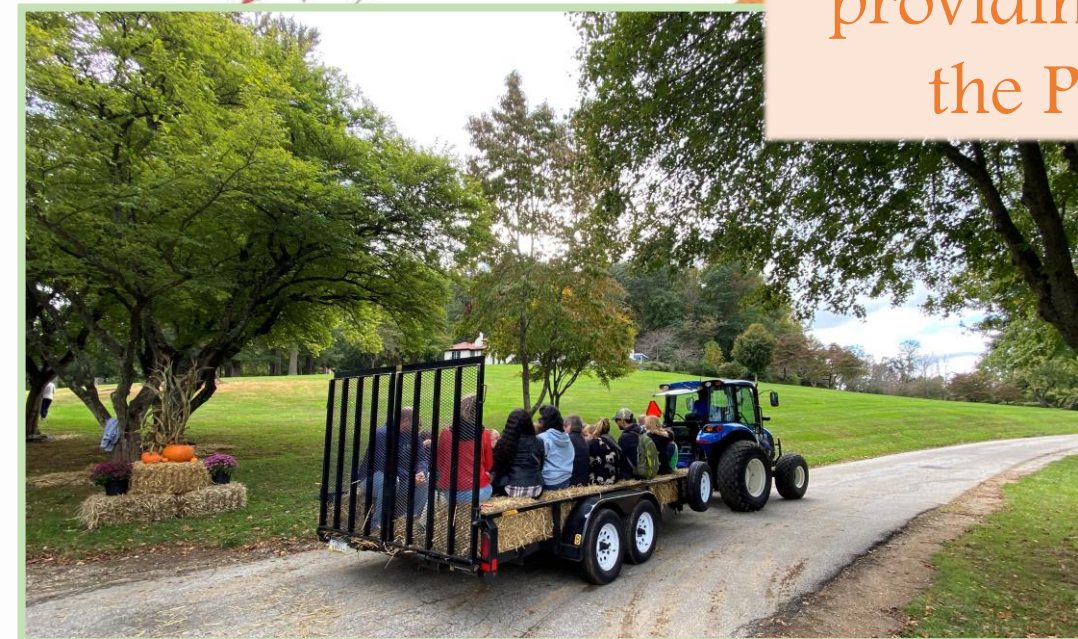
Food and activity lines

Children enjoyed activities such as gem mining, pony rides, a mechanical bull ride, an inflatable maze, and a game of dodgeball with Family Phys Ed!











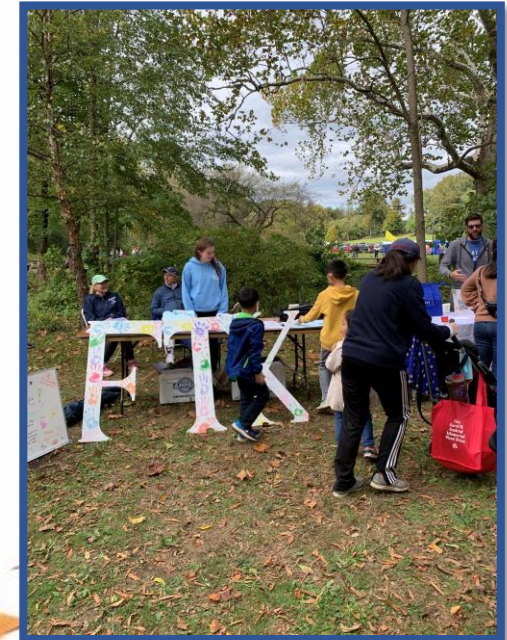
