RESOLUTION 2022-120 RADNOR TOWNSHIP

A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE KEYSTONE RECREATION, PARK AND CONSERVATION FUND LIBRARY GRANT FOR THE NON-ROUTINE MAINTENANCE/REHABILITATION OF THE ORIGINAL SHINGLED PORTION OF RADNOR MEMORIAL LIBRARY ROOF IN THE AMOUNT OF \$47,000 AND LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS OF \$47,000

WHEREAS, Radnor Township ("Township") and the Memorial Library of Radnor Township ("Library") wish to rehabilitate the shingled portion of the Radnor Memorial Library roof; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to apply to the Pennsylvania Department of Education ("PDE") Keystone Recreation, Park, and Conservation Fund Grant Program for Public Libraries for the purpose of carrying out this project; and

WHEREAS, the Township understands the grant amount requested must provide a dollar-for-dollar match of the total grant request in local, state, federal, or private funds or documented in-kind contributions; and

WHEREAS, the Township fully understands the application requirements and contracting process if awarded the rehabilitation grant dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Township ensures the undisturbed use of the facility as a public library for 50 years or the useful life of the project to be funded by the grant, whichever is shorter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED** that the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners authorizes the Township Manager to submit an application to the PDE for the 2023 Keystone Recreation, Park, and Conservation Fund Grant Program for Public Libraries; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Radnor Township agrees to, if selected for the 2023 Keystone Recreation, Park, and Conservation Fund Grant Program for Public Libraries, to:

- 1. Engage in contracting procedures including the Invitation to Bid and budget allocation;
- 2. Sign grant agreement documents;
- 3. Agree to submit reimbursement invoices and progress reports along with necessary supporting documentation on a quarterly basis;
- 4. Take all necessary action to complete the project associated with the grant agreement within a reasonable time.
