

2022 Leaf Season is Quickly Approaching

Leaf collection will run from October 31 through December 17.





Our Goal in 2022 is to shorten the time the leaves are on the streets

- Leaves on the street create safety concerns
- Leaves on the street contribute to stormwater and flooding issues



The Public Works Department focus for the 2022 Leaf Program:

- Collecting leaves twice in each District per the schedule
- Sweeping Streets after each collection
- Allowing Leaf Drop Off for residents on each Wednesday
- Mark inlets in Flood Prone Areas
- Continue to improve communications

Collection of Leaves Twice in Each District


- Each District will be given 1 week for the first and second collection
- Finishing each district by the end of the week, (weather dependent)
- Collection schedule will be updated daily with completed streets

Public Works Resources:

- Schedule 3 Saturdays during leaf season as part of the 2nd collection
- The Curbside Yard Waste Collection program will only occur on Wednesday, November 2 and Wednesday, December 7
- Eliminating weekly yard Waste collection during leaf season
 - ✓ Additional 15 workers help the leaf collection efforts on Wednesday
 - ✓ Allows the addition of 2 to 3 vacuums, rakes, blowers, and flagmen



Requesting Resident Help

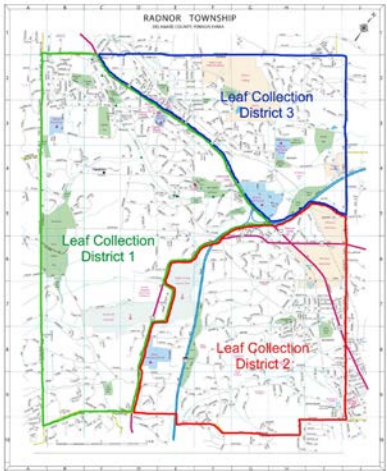
- Leaves to be placed at the curb as close to the first day of your district's collection as possible, and not more than 7 days prior
 - Have leaves at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on the 1st day of your district's collection
 - Do Not Block Storm Drains or Fire Hydrants
 - No sticks, rocks, dirt, pumpkins or other debris. Leaves only Please!
 - Do not park on piles of leaves
 - Please leave a 4 - 5" space between the leaves and the curb to allow for water flow in case of rain
 - If the crew has passed your home, please wait for the 2nd collection to put out more leaves.
 - Do Not Put out more leaves once the 2nd Collection has occurred.
 - Residents are responsible for their own leaf removal after the Township's Leaf Collection program has ended on December 16, 2022.

2022 - Leaf Drop Off Availability at Skunk Hollow

- Public Works Staff will be available to receive leaves at Skunk Hollow
 - Wednesdays Only during leaf season
 - 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
 - Radnor Residents Only (no contractors/landscapers permitted, even if working for a resident)
