Proposal to Revise Ward Boundaries

Requirement: Each ward must be within the acceptable population range.

Acceptable population range: 4,511–4,985 persons

Population mean: 4,748 persons

Goals:

- --> Fewer changes to existing boundaries is better.
- --> Unify student housing at each University (optimal is within one ward).
- --> Avoid instances where residential streets divide a ward.
- --> Keep polling place sites within existing precincts.



Common Features: Wards 4 and 7

Each option shares some common features worth noting.

Because of a census block anomaly, Riley Hall on Villanova Campus is separated from the rest of the campus.



>> Sprout Rd is new boundary of Ward 4.

Census blocks moved from Ward 3 to Ward 4 (401 persons) to bring Ward 4 within population requirements.

>> Neighborhood moved into one ward.

Census blocks moved from Ward 7 to Ward 4 (171 persons)

>> Villanova — South Campus Student Housing in one ward.

Census block moved from Ward 4 to Ward 7 (243 persons — likely students)

Other Common Features:

Additional common features worth noting.

- >> The current boundaries of Ward 5 and 6 do not change.
- >> The proposed Ward 4 boundaries are the same in each option.
- >> The proposed Ward 7 boundaries are nearly the same in each option.
- >> Ward 1, 2, and 3 boundaries vary the most between options.


After modifying the other wards:

- > Ward 3 remains overpopulated by about 600 persons.
- > Ward 1 and 2 are collectively underpopulated by about 600 persons.

>> Eastern University Student Housing in one ward.


Option A key features:

>> Ward 3 retains Villanova. About 600 persons are moved from the upper portion of the district to bring Ward 3 within population requirements.

>> Ward 2 gains 115 persons from Ward 1.

>> One polling place from Ward 3 had to move into Ward 1 with this configuration.

Option B key features:

>> Ward 3 retains its upper portion and instead shifts population from the Villanova campus into Ward 2. >> Because of the size of the census blocks in the Villanova campus, about 600 persons are moved from Ward 1 to bring Ward 3 within population requirements. >> Eastern University is entirely in Ward 1 (it had been primarily in Ward 2).

Option C key features:

>> All Villanova student housing (except South Campus) is moved into Ward 2.

>> Eastern University is entirely in Ward 3 (it had been primarily in Ward 2).

>> All of the population in Ward 2-1 is moved to either Ward 1 or Ward 3.
