On 4/1/2023 Radnor Police Department received numerous complaints for attempted and successful thefts from unlocked vehicles. The incidents occurred on 4/1/23 between 0100 and 0200hrs. on streets along Sproul Rd. including: Woodstock Rd., Comrie Dr., Spring Mill Rd., Campwoods Rd/Ci. and Vassar Ci. Residents are reminded to ensure valuables are removed and the doors are locked on their vehicles. Please call 911 if you see something suspicious or have further information.

On Tuesday, 4/4/23, at approximately 8:38 PM, store security of the the T.J. Maxx Store, located at 550 E. Lancaster Av., reported a retail theft that had just occurred. Security advised a Hispanic male and a Hispanic female were seen on video removing security magnets from several products and then exiting the store with those items without making payment. The value of the stolen items was approximately \$480.00.

On Thursday, 4/6/2023, the resident of the Crestwood Apartments, 421 E. Lancaster Av., reports a theft from their storage unit. The resident reports that sometime between January 2023 and March 27, 2023 all the items were removed from their storage locker.

On Thursday, 4/6/2023, at approximately 5:09 PM, the resident of the 400 block of Boxwood Rd. reports their vehicle was stolen from their driveway. The vehicle was last seen in the driveway ay approximately 1:30 PM on the same day. The keys were left in the car at the time of the theft.

On Thursday, 4/6/2023, at approximately 5:09 PM, the resident of the 400 block of Boxwood Rd. reports their vehicle was stolen from their driveway. The vehicle was last seen in the driveway ay approximately 1:30 PM on the same day. The keys were left in the car at the time of the theft.

On Thursday, 4/6/2023, at approximately 8:45 PM store employees of the T.J. Maxx store, located at 550 E. Lancaster Av., reported a smash and grab theft had just occurred. Employees report two black males and a black female entered the store and smashed out the glass display cases in jewelry department. The actors removed a large amount of jewelry and fled the store without paying. The actors fled the area in a black Jeep.

On the night of 4/9/2023, the Radnor Township Police were advised of two residential burglaries on the 700 block of Woodlea Rd. Both residences had windows smashed to gain access, and it appears that both burglaries occurred sometime Sunday, 4/9/2023 while the residents were not at home.

On Saturday, 4/16/2023, the victim discovered that her wallet was stolen from inside of their purse while they were in the Amada Restaurant, located at 555 E. Lancaster Av. The theft occurred at approximately 10:00 PM and along with all of the victim's credits, cash and other personal information was taken.

Radnor Police discovered a damaged package in the roadway, addressed to Dr. James Vito. 523 E. Lancaster Av. Investigation revealed that the package was delivered to the doctor's office sometime on Thursday, 4/13/2023, and stolen from its delivery location.

On Tuesday, 4/18/2023, staff from the T.J. Maxx Store made a late report, concerning a retail theft that had occurred on 4/16/2023. Video surveillance showed two black females place a large amount of items into a bag and exit the store without making any payment. This theft occurred on Sunday, 4/16/2023, at approximately 7:37 PM.

On Thursday, 4/20/2023, at approximately 1:50 PM, the victim reported their wallet was stolen while they were at the Chipotle Restaurant, located at 323 E. Lancaster Av. The victim reported she left the restaurant and a short time later realized she left her pocketbook on at her seat. When she returned to retrieve her pocketbook, she discovered that her wallet was missing from inside of it.

On Saturday, 4/22/2023, at approximately 6:01 PM, staff from the Wine and Spirits Store, located at 127 W. Lancaster Av., reported a retail theft had just occurred. Staff advised that a black male, with long black dreads, exited the store without paying for a bottle of liquor.

On Sunday, 4/23/2023, at approximately 9:46 AM, the resident of the 500 block of Chaumont Dr. witnessed their vehicle being stolen from their driveway. The resident observed a black male wearing black pants and a white thermal shirt, walk up their driveway and enter their Mercedes. The keys were left in the vehicle. The vehicle began to back out of the drive and was driven away by the black male.

On Monday, 4/24/2023, store security at the T.J. Maxx Store, located at 550 E. Lancaster Av., reported a retail theft that occurred a day earlier on 4/23/2023. Video surveillance shows two black females enter the store and place a large number of items into bags and exit the store without making payment.

On 4/22/23, at approximately 7:25 AM, actors stole the used cooking oil from the rear of three businesses located in the 800 block of E. Lancaster Av. Video showed an Hispanic male and an Hispanic female, operating a white panel van, removed the used cooking oil from the rear of Campus Corner, Wingers, and Novagrill.

On 4/25/2023, security from the T.J. Maxx Store, located at 550 E. Lancaster Av., reported a retail theft that had occurred on Monday, 4/24/2023. Security reported that five actors, two black males and three black females were observed placing approximately 57 items into their shopping carts. All five fled the store without making payment. The total value of the theft was approximately \$1,269.45.

Sometime over night between 4/30/2023 and 5/1/2023 vehicles were entered on Gulph Creek Rd. and had items stolen and a vehicle was stolen from the 700 block of Woodcrest Rd. The stolen vehicle was a 2022 black Nissan Sentra and the keys were left inside of the car.

The Radnor Police respects citizens' privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties by emphasizing behavior, rather than appearance, in identifying suspicious activity. Factors such as race, ethnicity, and/or religious affiliation are not suspicious. The public should only report suspicious behavior and situations (e.g., an unattended backpack or package, or someone breaking into a vehicle or restricted area). Moreover, any physical descriptions are based on victim and witness statements provided to the Radnor Police at the time the incident was reported or developed through investigation.

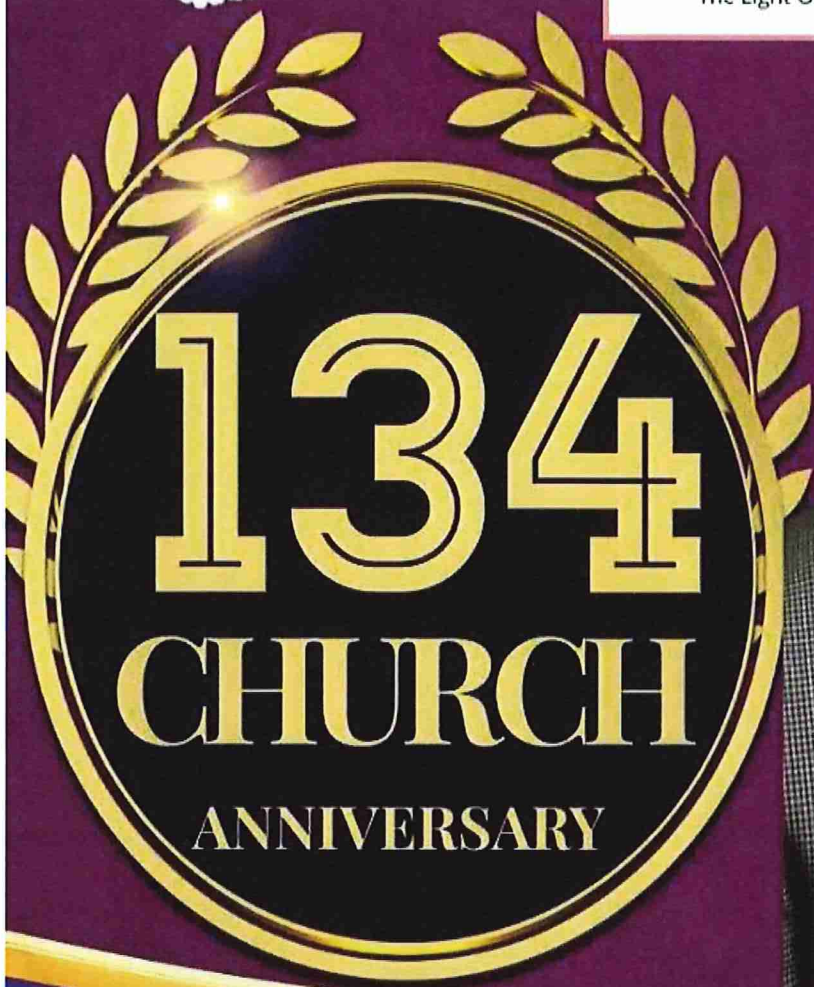
