Retail Theft - 201 Bryn Mawr Av. - Wawa

On Tuesday, 8/1/2023, at approximately 6:47 PM, the Wawa, located at 201 Bryn Mawr Av. reported a retail theft had just occurred. Surveillance video showed a black male, wearing a black shirt and gray pants exit the store with an undetermined amount of items without paying.

Theft from Vehicle - Delmont Apartments - 421 Morris Rd.

The resident of 421 Morris Rd., the Delmont Apartments, reported a theft from his vehicle that occurred sometime overnight between 8/11 and 8/12 2023. Taken from the unlocked vehicle was approximately \$520.00 in cash.

Theft of Vehicle/Theft from Motor Vehicles

From Sunday, 8/13/2023 to 8/14/2023 several vehicles were entered, and one was stolen from the Bryn Mawr section of Radnor Township. All the vehicles that were entered were left unsecure at the time and had various items removed from inside of them. The stolen car was left unlocked with the keys inside and was subsequently located in a different jurisdiction.

Retail Theft - Giant Store - 550 E. Lancaster Av.

On 8/16/2023, the staff from the Giant Food Market, located at 550 E. Lancaster Av., reported a retail theft that had occurred on 8/5/2023. Store security advised that on that date, two white males, entered the store and removed several items without making payment. The total value of the theft was approximately \$162.99.

600 block of Heather La. - Stolen Vehicle

Sometime overnight between 8/27/2023 and 8/28/2023 a vehicle was stolen from the 600 block of Heather La. The vehicle was removed from the driveway of the residence. The car was tracked and ultimately located in Wilmington, DE.

Retail Theft - T.J. Maxx Store - 550 E. Lancaster Av.

On Tuesday, 8/29/2023, the T.J. Maxx Store made a late reported retail theft incident. T.J. Max officials advised that on Monday, 8/28/2023 at approximately 8:40 PM, two black females exited the store with approximately \$462.82 worth of merchandise without making payment. The two females were last seen leaving in a black Hyundai Kona.

Theft from Vehicle - 275 Bryn Mawr Av.

Sometime overnight between 8/30/2023 and 8/31/2023, a vehicle parked in the lot of 275 Bryn Mawr Av. was entered. The vehicle, which was left unlocked, was ransacked, and had several dollars in cash and loose change stolen.

Criminal Mischief to Auto - 1030 E. Lancaster Av.

The resident of 1030 E. Lancaster Av. reports their vehicle was vandalized sometime overnight between 8/30/23023 and 8/31/2023. The vehicle had its front windshield broken.

The Radnor Police respects citizens' privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties by emphasizing behavior, rather than appearance, in identifying suspicious activity. Factors such as race, ethnicity, and/or religious affiliation are not suspicious. The public should only report suspicious behavior and situations (e.g., an unattended backpack or package, or someone breaking into a vehicle or restricted area). Moreover, any physical descriptions are based on victim and witness statements provided to the Radnor Police at the time the incident was reported or developed through investigation.

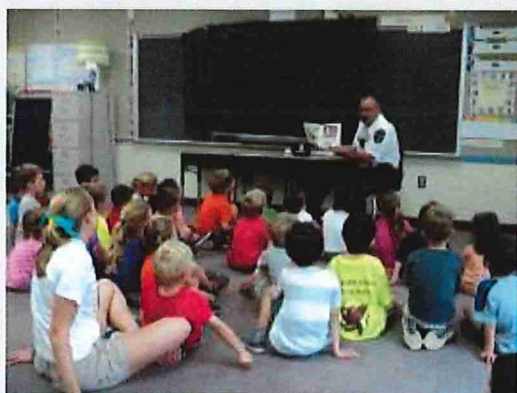




Reading with the Radnor Police
