# WPP Highlights over the last 6 months

### 2022 Program and Events:

11 weddings/private events, 23 educational and health and wellness programs/classes, 5 music concerts, 17 days of business/school/nonprofit meetings, 2 memorial receptions, 2 children's birthday parties, 1 Eco camp, 1 Health and Wellness Festival, 1 WPP Fall Fundraiser, 1 Holiday Open House

- Keystone Communities Program Funding from Senator Amanda Cappelletti in the amount of \$89,500 towards kitchen renovation
- In collaboration with Radnor Township, installed a security system at the Mansion
- Have 22 private events booked through our caterer
- Started to develop a Strategic Plan to provide our nonprofit guidance over the next 3 to 5 years
- Working to finish painting the exterior of the Mansion
- 50th Anniversary Celebration!



### Treasurer's Report - Terminology Level Set

- Revenue and expenses for non-profits are "functionally allocated" to one of the following categories:
  - Program Revenue/Expense
  - Fundraising Revenue/Expense
  - Management and General Expense

Note: Certain expenses such as salary, insurance and utilities are proportionally (but not equally) allocated across the above categories.

- In the IRS lexicon the WPP oversees two "Programs":
  - Program 1: Renovation, Restoration and Maintenance of the Willows Mansion
  - Program 2: Public Programming, Events and Mansion Usage
