

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-121

A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE STUMP GRINDING, TREE REMOVAL AND GROUND RESTORATION WORK AT THE WEST WAYE CEMETERY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$7,500.

WHEREAS, pursuant to State Act of May 10, 1923, when a cemetery is abandoned by a church that no longer exists, maintenance of the cemetery falls to the municipality; and

WHEREAS, The West Wayne Cemetery has fallen to the Township for maintenance and care, who has paid to have the cemetery mowed; and

WHEREAS, volunteers have been working at the cemetery to clean the area of invasive vines, weeds, and provide general cleanup; and


WHEREAS, several large trees, stumps, and a broken fence need to be removed along with significant earthwork, all of which require heavy equipment and cannot be completed through the efforts of volunteers; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners amended the original proposal of \$11,300 down to “not to exceed” \$7,500 during the public Board of Commissioner’s Meeting held on November 27, 2023 with the understanding that the Township Public Works Department will help with in-kind work at the Cemetery.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** the Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township does hereby authorize the Radnor Township Public Works Department and Shriener Tree Care to do the work as proposed at the West Wayne Cemetery in an amount not to exceed \$7,500.
