## **Radnor Township Parks & Recreation Department / Willows Park Preserve Informational Notice: The Willows Park Concert Blast!**

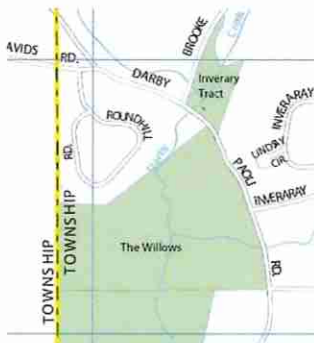
Dear Radnor Township Neighbors,

I would like to take an opportunity to tell you about an exciting event that will be taking place at The Willows Park and Mansion this July as the Radnor Township Parks & Recreation Department and the Willows Park Preserve team up to host the Willows Park Concert Blast on Friday, July 19 (event rain date will be on Saturday, July 20) from 6:00 PM to approximately 10:30 PM. This event will include live music, activities, food, refreshments, and fireworks at approximately 9:00 PM.

Due to the impact of traffic, safety, and activity awareness, we are providing notice about this upcoming event. There will be an increased amount of vehicle traffic around and throughout the park during the event, along with traffic disruptions along Darby-Paoli Road. For extra safety, the Radnor Township Police Department and Radnor Fire Department will be on site to support the event.

**Fireworks begin at approximately 9:00 PM** – Fireworks will take place at The Willows Park at approximately 9:00 PM and will last about 20 minutes. In the event of inclement weather on the evening of the event, the fireworks time may be adjusted. We want you to be aware that lights and loud sounds will be generated as a result of the fireworks taking place within the park.
