Vehicle Break Ins - Willow Park - 490 Darby Paoli Rd.

On Wednesday, 1/3/2024, at approximately 4:28 PM, a female caller advised that two unknown males were breaking into cars parked at the Willows, located at 490 Darby Paoli Rd. On scene, Police located several vehicles that had windows broken and were advised by the witness that two males left the parking lot in a white SUV, prior to Police arrival.

Theft/Suspicious Persons - 275 Bryn Mawr Av. - "C" Building

On Tuesday, 1/9/2024 at approximately 5:16 PM the resident of "B" Building in the Radwyn Apartments, located at 275 Bryn Mawr Av. advised two suspicious males inside of his building, knocking on his door. The resident advised two black males looking to gain access to the apartment to change the PECO electrical meter. The resident advises that there is NOT a meter in his apartment and denied the males entry. After confirming with management that PECO was not in the area, the resident went to the store unit area. There he observed several units forced open, including his. The resident reports various items missing from his storage unit.

Retail Theft - - 201 Bryn Mawr Av. - the Wawa Store

On Friday, 1/12/2024, at approximately 4:06 PM, a retail theft occurred at the Wawa, located at 201 Bryn Mawr Av. The actor, a black male, approximately six feet tall, in his twenties, removed several items and fled the store without making payment.

Theft from Vehicle - 100 block of Brooke Farm Rd.

On Saturday, 1/13/2024, at approximately 4:50 AM, a vehicle parked in a driveway of the 100 block of Brooke Farm Rd. was entered. An unknown actor, entered the unlocked vehicle and removed a wallet containing cash and credit cards.

Suspicious Person - 300 block of Edgehill Rd.

The resident of the 300 block of Edgehill Rd. reported an unknown person walking on their property in the early morning hours of 1/13/2024. The resident's ring camera captured a subject walk down their driveway at 3:44 AM and then exit their driveway at 3:51 AM. At this time, no other crimes were discovered.

Theft from Vehicle - N. Wayne Av. Train Station

The owner of a vehicle parked in the N. Wayne Av. train station made a late report of a theft from their vehicle. The victim advises that sometime on 1/12/2024, their unlocked vehicle was entered and a lap top was removed.

Attempted Burglary - 500 block of Huston Rd.

On Friday, 1/19/2024, at approximately 5:45 PM, the resident of the 500 block of Huston Rd. reported that an unknown person or persons just broke the rear door of their residence and attempted to gain entrance into their home. At approximately 6:30 PM Radnor Police were able to locate and take the actors involved in this attempted burglary into custody. At this time the situation was deemed to be under control.

Theft of Purse - 215 Sugartown Rd. - Club La Maison

On 1/26/2024, at approximately 12:30 PM, the victim had their purse stolen while they were at 215 Sugartown Rd., Club La Maison. The purse was stolen out of a club supplied locker.

Theft of Purse - 550 E. Lancaster Av. - Home Sense

On Saturday, 1/27/2024 at approximately 2:25 PM the victim had their purse stolen while they were shopping at 550 E. Lancaster Av., the Home Sense Store. The purse was stolen from their pocketbook while it was left in their shopping cart.

Theft of Wallet - Home Sense - 550 E. Lancaster Av.

On Tuesday, 1/30/2024 at approximately 2:15 hours, the victim reported their wallet was stolen while shopping at the Home Sense, located at 550 E. Lancaster Av. The wallet was removed from a pocketbook that was in the victim's presence the whole time they were shopping. The victim believes that they were distracted by unknown actors when the wallet was stolen.

Theft of Package - 430 E. Lancaster Av. the Brynfield Apartments

On Tuesday, 1/30/2024, at approximately 6:55 PM, the victim discovered that a package delivered to their residence was stolen. The package was delivered by Amazon some time earlier that day.

The Radnor Police respects citizens' privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties by emphasizing behavior, rather than appearance, in identifying suspicious activity. Factors such as race, ethnicity, and/or religious affiliation are not suspicious. The public should only report suspicious behavior and situations (e.g., an unattended backpack or package, or someone breaking into a vehicle or restricted area). Moreover, any physical descriptions are based on victim and witness statements provided to the Radnor Police at the time the incident was reported or developed through investigation.
