Crime Alert - Residential Burglaries

On Friday 3/1/2024 at approximately 2230Hrs Radnor Police responded to the 700 Block of Cornerstone Lane (Bryn Mawr section of Radnor Twp.) for a residential burglary discovered. Entry was made through an unlocked first floor door and several items were taken.

On Sunday 3/3/2024 at 1032Hrs a Radnor Patrol Officer discovered a burglary in the 700Blk of Bryn Mawr Ave (Bryn Mawr section of Radnor Twp). Entry was made by breaking a second story window and several items were taken.

Radnor Police are asking residents that have further information to contact 911. Additionally, dial 911 if any unknown individuals attempt to contact you at your residence. No matter how innocent they appear, actors may be evaluating the occupancy of your residence.

The Radnor Police respects citizens' privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties by emphasizing behavior, rather than appearance, in identifying suspicious activity. Factors such as race, ethnicity, and/or religious affiliation are not suspicious. The public should only report suspicious behavior and situations (e.g., an unattended backpack or package, or someone breaking into a vehicle or restricted area). Moreover, any physical descriptions are based on victim and witness statements provided to the Radnor Police at the time the incident was reported or developed through investigation.
