

GENERAL PARKING INFORMATION

- KIOSK PARKING IS ENFORCED MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY FROM 8:00 A.M. UNTIL 6 P.M.
- KIOSK PARKING IS "FREE" AND AVAILABLE TO ANYONE ON EVENINGS AFTER 6:00 P.M. AND ANYTIME ON SUNDAYS
- KIOSK PARKING IS ALSO "FREE" ON THE FOLLOWING DESIGNATED HOLIDAYS. NEW YEARS DAY, MEMORIAL DAY, FOURTH OF JULY, LABOR DAY, THANKSGIVING AND CHRISTMAS DAY.
- PLEASE NOTE THAT WE DO ISSUE TICKETS ON HOLIDAYS
 THAT THE TOWNSHIP BUILDING IS OPEN, SUCH AS
 COLUMBUS DAY, PRESIDENTS DAY AND VETERANS DAY,



- .25 CENTS PER HALF HOUR. UP TO 10 HOURS IN DESIGNATED "LONG TERM" LOTS



PARKING TICKETS



- PLEASE UNDERSTAND THAT ONCE A TICKET IS ISSUED THE METER ATTENDANT "CANNOT" TAKE IT BACK
- GETTING CHANGE AND/OR ENTERING THE WRONG SPACE NUMBER, OR NOT COMPLETING THE TRANSACTION CANNOT BE CONSIDERED BY THE TOWNSHIP
- PARKING DISPUTES WILL NOT BE HANDLED AT THE TOWNSHIP BUILDING, BY MAIL, OR OVER THE PHONE, PARKING DISPUTES ARE HANDLED AT THE DISTRICT COURT

HOW TO DISPUTE A PARKING TICKET




- DO NOT PAY THE TICKET
- AFTER 10 DAYS YOU WILL RECEIVE A NOTICE IN THE MAIL STATING THAT YOU OWE A LATE FEE, IGNORE THIS NOTICE!
- AFTER APPROXIMATELY 30 DAYS YOU
 WILL RECEIVE A CITATION FROM THE
 DISTRICT COURT. THIS IS WHERE YOU
 HAVE THE OPTION TO PLEAD NOT
 GUILTY.
- PLEAD NOT GUILTY, RETURN THE
 CITATION TO DISTRICT COURT; YOU
 WILL BE NOTIFIED BY THE COURT OF
 YOUR HEARING DATE. YOUR DISPUTE
 WILL THEN BE HEARD BY THE DISTRICT
 COURT JUDGE, AT WHICH TIME YOU
 WILL BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO
 TESTIFY.

PERMIT PARKING

 IT IS THE LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO ASSIST, WHEN FEASABLE, RESIDENTS OF AN AREA OF THE TOWNSHIP WHO SUFFER FROM VEHICULAR CONGESTION RESULTING FROM THE EXISTENCE OF LIMITED NUMBERS OF CURBSIDE PARKING SPACES AND LARGE NUMBERS OF NONRESIDENTS COMPETING WITH RESIDENTS FOR CURBSIDE PARKING SPACES AND/OR FROM PARKING REGULATIONS DESIGNED TO CONTROL THE FLOW OF VEHICLES WHICH ULTIMATELY WORK A HARDSHIP ON RESIDENTS OF SUCH AREAS.

PURCHASING A PERMIT



- PERMITS CAN BE PURCHASED AT THE TOWNSHIP BUILDING DURING BUSINESS HOURS.
- NON RESIDENT PERMITS COST \$75.00
- NON RESIDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE THEIR DRIVERS LICENSE, REGISTRATION, PROOF OF INSURANCE AS WELL AS A COPY OF THE SIGNED LEASE

RESIDENTIAL PERMITS



- RESIDENTIAL PERMITS COST \$25.00
- RESIDENTS OVER 65 PAY \$10.00
- RESIDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE THEIR DRIVERS LICENSE, REGISTRATION, AND PROOF OF INSURANCE
- RESIDENTS WHO RENT THEIR PROPERTY MUST ALSO PROVIDE A COPY OF THEIR LEASE
- YOU ARE CONSIDERED A
 RESIDENT IF YOUR DRIVERS
 LICENSE AND REGISTRATION
 MATCH YOUR PROPERTY
 ADDRESS

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- HOW MUCH TIME DO I HAVE TO PAY A PARKING TICKET?
 You have 10 days from receipt of the ticket to pay before a late fee is applied.
- DO YOU NEED TO PLACE THE RECEIPT ON YOUR DASHBOARD?
 Parking is pay by space, so there is no need to place your receipt on the dashboard.
- WHAT TIME ARE THE KIOSKS ENFORCED?
 Kiosks are enforced 8 am till 6 pm Monday through Saturday except holidays.
- IS A RECEIPT ISSUED?
 You "MUST" press the green print button to complete your transaction!
 A receipt will be issued.
- I WANT TO MOVE MY CAR FROM ONE LOT TO ANOTHER. DO I HAVE TO PAY AGAIN? When you pay at the kiosk you are basically renting a space. When you move your vehicle you will have to pay for the space that you move into.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- HOW DOES PARKING ENFORCEMENT KNOW THAT I PAID?
 Meter attendants are equipped with handheld devices that are able to communicate with the kiosks, therefore letting them know which spaces are paid and which are not.
- HOW DO YOU ADD TIME TO THE KIOSK?
 First, you can only extend time on 10 hour spaces at this time. To do do so, press 2 on the machine. You will then be asked to provide information from your receipt.
- I PURCHASED "SMARTCARDS" DOES THIS ALLOW ME TO PARK ANYWHERE IN THE TOWNSHIP?
 - Smartcards can only be used in the Bellevue lot, the South Wayne Lot and the Waynewood/Louella Lot.
- I'm having an issue paying a ticket online. Who do I contact?
