Additional Programming Activity

- Coordinated with winter, spring and summer program and event vendors and instructors on planning
 and expectations along with safe delivery of programs related to COVID-19. We continued to modify
 our seasonal planning efforts with backup plans due to the uncertainty related to the pandemic.
- Radnor Day Camp Summer 2021
 - Comprehensive planning underway/registration opened on Monday, March 8th
 - Camp dates are Monday, June 28 to Friday, August 6 (no camp on Monday, July 5) and will take place at Radnor Activity Center with a potential alternate site at Radnor Middle School or Radnor Elementary School
 - Camp <u>celebrates its 80th year in 2021</u> with structured outdoor and (limited indoor) activities
 that will include the return of several staff members
 - Camp will operate with regimented <u>Health & Safety Operating Procedures</u> and <u>'Camp FAQs'</u> have been developed to answer questions about camp.
 - Meetings are taking place with Department and camp staff to plan camp in the areas of daily schedule and activities, logistics, and staffing.
 - Scholarships are available and we are actively coordinating with the RTSD Social Work Department along with other community contacts.
 - Meetings and coordination are also taking place with the RTSD Operations, Special Education, and Transportation Departments.
 - Staff recruitment (<u>Virtual Summer Camp Job Fair</u> will take place on Tuesday 3/23 and Saturday 4/17), interviews, and the hiring process is underway along with revisions to the Camp Staff Handbook and training program; met with Township Labor Council and Risk Management Consulting firm on various operating items including diversity training.
 - Coordinated parent communications, website updates, marketing, online registration, and inventory/procurement of all related supplies
- Updated job descriptions and engaged staff recruitment for Summer Wizarding Camp.
- Continued sponsorship and partnership development with local businesses and community organizations.
- Coordinated and evaluated additional upcoming events Bike Rodeo, Great American Backyard Campout, Summer Concerts/Movie Night, Wiffleball Classic, and upcoming grand openings for Emlen Tunnell Park Comfort Station and Bo Connor/Warren Filipone Park Improvements.

Parks & Recreation Facilities

Current Status Amidst Covid-19:

 All Parks & Trails and corresponding amenities are OPEN for usage including permitted usage in accordance with state and federal guidelines (many water fountains remain closed) – stake signage was developed and has been posted regarding safe practices for usage and mask wearing.

Radnor Activity Center is OPEN with health and safety guidelines in place for Department programming, Radnor Youth Basketball, and several recurring rentals including several American Red Cross Blood Drives, and the Carol H. Axelrod Memorial Blood Drive on Tuesday, May 4th.

- Coordinated with our contracted cleaning company on various items.
- Coordinated electrical repairs of 2nd floor electrical panel and gym lighting replacements
- Managed ongoing water intrusion and roof evaluations/currently working on comprehensive building improvement outline and updated costs.

Park Areas/Picnic Rentals: Coordinated seasonal reservations to date:

- Clem Macrone Park (? rentals)
- Fenimore Woods (4 rentals)

<u>Athletic Fields</u>: Continued coordinating and scheduling field and light schedules with users for several park locations and Radnor Memorial Park for the winter and upcoming spring and summer seasons.

Parks Department Activity (submitted by Parks Supervisor/Rick Foster):

- Assisted with continued Township snow removal process.
- Trash collected from all Township parks weekly.
- Started spring park and field restorations including playground repairs.

Park Project Updates:

Scout Projects

- Coordinated with Eagle Scout candidate updated project scope for installation of steps along steep area of the Willows Trail.
- Coordinated various improvements with Troop 284 Saw Mill Bridge restoration and stabilization; Skunk Hollow Trail/Garden sign painting; Kiosk track repairs/adding of Orienteering Map.
- **Bishop Richard Allen Park** met with members of the community and the Bethel AME Church of Ardmore to discuss the prospect of special recognition signage for Bishop Richard Allen at the park.
- Emlen Tunnell Park: continued to work with Septa to prepare for removal of the bridge structures (scheduled to take place March 26th to 28th) with corresponding tree and fence replacements to later follow; grand opening ceremony are being considered for summer 2021.
- Fenimore Woods Rehabilitation Project: Continued to work with Gilmore & Associates on bid/design development and refinement (the project has been presented to the BOC and they have authorized bid); a contract for additional services and grant preparation for the PA Department of Natural Resources Community Conservation Partnership Program (DCNR C2P2) was approved by the BOC agenda in February and work is underway; tree removal and replacement plan was approved at the July 2020 Shade Tree Commission Meeting; currently working with the Delaware County Conservation District on the NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System/US Environmental Protection Agency regulated) application process that has been submitted to the state; prepared and received a \$50,000 DCED Keystone Communities Project Grant; working on a second DCED Greenways, Trail and Recreation Program Grant.

- <u>Harford Park Trail Construction</u>: Project is underway with anticipated completion and tree plantings in the spring.
- Odorisio Park & Cowan Park Basketball Court Renovations project to renovate both park
 basketball courts are underway, and we have reviewed a draft plan and are awaiting revisions;
 project details are being refined with anticipated bid for both projects this spring.
- Radnor TAP Trail: Project including 3 trail sections around Radnor High School; S. Ithan Avenue connecting the Villanova Train Station to the Haverford Township border; and West Wayne Avenue connecting the Wayne Train Station with the Radnor Trail; construction was awarded in November by the Board of Commissioners; preconstruction meeting took place along with meeting with the Delaware County Conservation District and the project is slated to begin in early March.
- West Wayne Preserve/Friends of Radnor Trails Park: Bid anticipated soon for the Wetlands Enhancement/Stormwater Management Project.
- Willows Park: Bridge replacement is underway along Darby-Paoli Road near the park entrance
 causing continued closure to the park entrance through spring. Bid development underway for the
 domestic water and fire service project.
- **Willows Park Preserve:** Township staff has continued to work with the WPP on building upgrades and the delivery of indoor/outdoor events.
- **Veterans & First Responders Park:** continued to meet with the American Legion in the development and planning for the memorial project within the park.

Park and Trail Improvements:

A bond ordinance was voted in October 2015 by the Board of Commissioners for parks and trails (\$5.75M - \$4.3M Parks/\$1.45M Trails) – we have continued working towards completion of the various park projects that have been outlined; for an update on the trail projects and their status, please see the September 2020 Parks Board Meeting presentation.
