2021 Pennsylvania Recreation & Parks Society Conference/Awards

 Our Department received the 2019 Excellence in Programming Award for the 2018 Night at the Ball Park & Wiffleball Classic Event as well as recognition the 2020 Excellence in Programming Award for 'Programming in the Pandemic' for the 2020 Spooktacular Park & Trail Scavenger Hunt; staff took part in various virtual educational conference sessions in March.

Additional Programming Activity

- Coordination and planning for all in-season and upcoming programming and events.
- Coordinated with winter, spring and summer program and event vendors and instructors on planning
 and expectations, contractual agreement development, and safe delivery of programs related to
 COVID-19 (we continued to modify our seasonal planning efforts with backup plans due to the
 uncertainty related to the pandemic).
- Radnor Day Camp Summer 2021
 - Comprehensive planning underway/Camp dates are Monday, June 28 to Friday, August 6 (no camp on Monday, July 5) and will take place at Radnor Activity Center with a potential alternate site at Radnor Middle School or Radnor Elementary School
 - Camp <u>celebrates its 80th year in 2021</u> with structured outdoor and (limited indoor) activities that will include the return of several staff members
 - Camp will operate with regimented <u>Health & Safety Operating Procedures</u> and <u>'Camp FAQs'</u> have been developed to answer questions about camp.
 - Scholarships are available and we are actively coordinating with the RTSD Social Work Department along with other community contacts.
 - Meetings are taking place with Department and camp staff to plan camp in the areas of daily schedule and activities, logistics, and staffing.
 - Meetings and coordination are also taking place with the RTSD Operations, Special Education and Transportation Departments.
 - Staff recruitment (<u>Virtual Summer Camp Job Fairs</u> scheduled for Tuesday 3/23 and Saturday 4/17); interviews and the hiring process is underway along with revisions to the Camp Staff Handbook and training program particularly in the areas of Diversity & Inclusion, Sexual Harassment and Discrimination and Child Abuse & Awareness I've been working closely with Township Risk Management Consulting firms on updating our Staff Handbook, Pre-Training and In-Person Training items relative to these areas.
 - Coordinated parent communications, website updates, marketing, online registration, and inventory/procurement of all related supplies
- Engaged in curriculum planning, logistics, and staff recruitment for Summer Wizarding Camp.
- Continued sponsorship and partnership development with local businesses and community organizations – met with various groups and businesses.

 Coordinated and evaluated additional upcoming events – Summer Concerts, Odorisio Park Music and Movie Event, and upcoming grand openings for Emlen Tunnell Park Comfort Station, Bo Connor/Warren Filipone Park Improvements, and the Harford Park Trail.

Parks & Recreation Facilities

Current Status Amidst Covid-19:

 All Parks & Trails and corresponding amenities are OPEN for usage including permitted usage in accordance with state and federal guidelines (many water fountains remain closed) – stake signage was developed and has been posted regarding safe practices for usage and mask wearing.

Radnor Activity Center is OPEN with health and safety guidelines in place for Department programming, and several recurring rentals including American Red Cross Blood Drives.

- Coordinated with our contracted cleaning company on various items.
- Coordinated electrical lighting changes in building vestibule.
- Developing building improvement outline and updated costs.

Park Areas/Picnic Rentals: Coordinated seasonal reservations to date:

- Clem Macrone Park (4 rentals)
- Dittmar Park (1 rental)
- Fenimore Woods 17 rentals)
- Willows Park (8 rentals, 3 are photography)

<u>Athletic Fields</u>: Continued coordinating and scheduling field and light schedules with multiple users at several park locations spring and summer seasons.

Parks Department Activity (submitted by Parks Supervisor/Rick Foster):

- Trash collected from all Township parks weekly.
- Conducted spring park and field restorations including playground repairs.
- Coordinated hazardous tree removals at parks.

Park Project Updates:

- **Bishop Richard Allen Park** working on partner project with members of the community and the Bethel AME Church of Ardmore regarding recognition signage for Bishop Richard Allen at the park.
- Bo Connor Park& Odorisio Park coordinated playground slide replacements with manufacturer;
 Odorisio Park main parking lot has limited usage due to local construction project staging, residents are asked to use the other park parking lots off West Wayne Avenue and Fairview Drive.
- Clem Macrone Park hazardous tree removals scheduled to take place; coordinated details with resident group and ordered memorial for the late James Pachioli.
- **Emlen Tunnell Park:** Septa removal of the bridge structures completed March 26-28; corresponding tree and fence replacements are being coordinated.
- Fenimore Woods Rehabilitation Project:
 - Continued to work with Gilmore & Associates on the revised bid/design development and refinement (the project has been presented to the BOC and they have authorized bid)
 - o Tree removal and replacement plan approved at the July 2020 Shade Tree Commission
 - Delaware County Conservation District/NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System/US Environmental Protection Agency regulated) application submitted to the state.
 - Highway Occupancy Permit received from PA DOT.
 - Staff reviewing increased deterioration of the pond weir and water management, Public Works assisting with temporary measures to limit impact on the pond.
 - o \$50,000 DCED Keystone Communities Project Grant received
 - \$250,000 PA Department of Natural Resources Community Conservation Partnership Program (DCNR C2P2) grant prepared and submitted.
 - DCED Greenways, Trail and Recreation Program Grant application underway.

- <u>Harford Park Trail Construction</u>: Project almost complete with punch list underway and upcoming tree plantings.
- Odorisio Park & Cowan Park Basketball Court Renovations project to renovate both park
 basketball courts underway with review of draft plan revisions; project details are being refined with
 anticipated bid for both projects this spring.
- Radnor Memorial Park repairs made to the field; turf field replacement likely in 2022.
- Radnor TAP Trail: Project including 3 trail sections around Radnor High School; S. Ithan Avenue connecting the Villanova Train Station to the Haverford Township border; and West Wayne Avenue connecting the Wayne Train Station with the Radnor Trail; construction was awarded in November by the Board of Commissioners; preconstruction meeting took place along with meeting with the Delaware County Conservation District and the project is slated to begin in early March.
- Skunk Hollow Park pilot meadow project to be expanded with educational features.
- West Wayne Preserve/Friends of Radnor Trails Park: Bid anticipated soon for the Wetlands Enhancement/Stormwater Management Project.
- Willows Park/Mansion:
 - Bridge replacement is underway along Darby-Paoli Road near the park entrance causing continued closure to the park entrance through spring.
 - o Bid development underway for the domestic water and fire service project.
 - Working with Willows Park Preserve on building upgrades, usage, and event coordination.
- **Veterans & First Responders Park:** continued to meet with the American Legion in the development and planning for the memorial project within the park.

Park and Trail Improvements:

A bond ordinance was voted in October 2015 by the Board of Commissioners for parks and trails (\$5.75M - \$4.3M Parks/\$1.45M Trails) – we have continued working towards completion of the various park projects that have been outlined; for an update on the trail projects and their status, please see the September 2020 Parks Board Meeting presentation.
