Superintendent Foreman Operators Laborers Drivers  EQUIPMENT USED: Excavator FEL Dump Truck Backhoe Hoe Pac Vibratory Roller Motorized Tamper Other	1) Onsite to observe site conditions and E&S controls due to rain. 2) Torcon installed silt sack inlet protection for I-223 and I-215. 3) Construction vehicles were observed entering and leaving the site onto Ithan Avenue which left mud on the sidewalks adjacent to Ithan Avenue. Torcon was advised and a laborer was observed shoveling and sweeping the affected areas. MJP also informed Torcon that additional inlet protection should be re-installed at I-221 to prevent any of the mud from directly entering the storm sewer. 4) Silt laden runoff was observed crossing the driveway entrance into Main Lot from Ithan Avenue. Runoff was traveling through the area protected by geotextile fabric and overflowing onto the driveway. Torcon added silt sock at the base of the curb into the driveway and above grade from I-223. This appeared to be sufficient for now, but Torcon stated that they would continue to monitor the situation. The runoff passing through the silt sock and entering the inlet protection did not appear to be silt laden. 5) JJD did not complete the installation of the modified 2A base in the location of the fire access lane. To address potential runoff concerns, the contractor built up a slight earthern berm to direct any runoff away from the entrance onto Ithan Avenue and towards an area of silt fence located south of the proposed fire access lane. There did not appear to be runoff exiting the site at this location, but Torcon stated they would continue to monitor the situation. 6) The storm manhole located south of I-308 appears to have slid off of the structure. Torcon was advised. Torcon stated that they would reset the manhole frame and cover. According to Torcon, final grade had not been set for this structure. 7) Sweeper Truck is onsite cleaning roadways and area of worksite just north of Pike Garage(Ithan Avenue and Lancaster Avenue) of tire tracks and minor sediment/debris.
