This is very slow work due to the size of the retaining wall and the small sections of stone used to cover it. 4.) Temporary striping was started today on all of the freshly paved parking areas. This is only a temporary striping for Villanova's upcoming graduation ceremonies. 5.) JJD continued working on site grading today to get more areas up to grade so that they may install stone and get these areas ready for the proposed blacktop to be installed. 6.) HBF and QCI were back onsite conitnuing with the wiring installation on the newly installed lightpole bases. 7.) Roma Concrete formed and poured another 500' of proposed curb today. 8.) JJD took multiple deliveries of crushed concrete and modified stone to be used for compaction within the roadways, sidewalks, and curb areas.
