Large track-hoe excavators are loading tri-axle dump trucks which are hauling the material to a stockpile area onsite. 2) Starfire (subcontract for Mayfield) has a street sweeper continuously cleaning the lot and adjacent roadways to manage dirt and dust issues. 3) Mayfield continued the construction of the tire scrubber area on the west side of the site; placing modified stone to build up the demolished sections of adjacent roadway. 4) Molly Concrete Contractors, Inc. and D.M. Sabia, Inc. (mason) continued construction of the foundations and walls of the western half of the west building. Foundation excavation spoils are being loaded into tri-axle dump trucks for export offsite. Concrete trucks and the mason's equipment remained on the paved and stoned sections of the lot, discarded portland based materials were placed in the prescribed dumpster(s) with liner. 5) Stock piled soils were protected at the end of the day with silt socks around the perimeter and covered in plastic sheeting for the weekend and wet weather. | | | |
