A large track-hoe excavator is loading triaxle dump trucks which are hauling the material offsite. Trucks are processing through a tire wash station to cut down on mud and debris being dropped offsite. Additionally, Mayfield has a street sweeper subcontracted to clean the site paved areas and surrounding roads.  2.) Mayfield placed stone for the new staging area for the mason adjacent to the proposed west-most dumpster pad area.  3.) Mayfield replaced the silt bag placed near MH-213 that was observed to be silt laden. The new bag and other site E&S controls appear to be functioning as required.  4.) Molly Concrete Contractors, Inc. and D.M. Sabia, Inc. (mason) continued construction of the foundations and walls of the west building. Foundation excavation spoils are being loaded into triaxle dump trucks for export offsite. Concrete trucks and the mason's equipment primarily remained on the paved and stoned sections of the lot, discarded portland based materials were placed in the prescribed dumpster(s).
