A large track-hoe excavator is loading triaxle dump trucks which are hauling the material offsite. Trucks are processing through a tire wash station to cut down on mud and debris being dropped offsite. Additionally, Mayfield has a street sweeper subcontracted to clean the site paved areas and surrounding roads. 3.) Roadways around the site are observed to be clean and free of debris, no build up of mud/dirt; the street sweeper continues to make rounds through the site and perimeter roads. 4.) Molly Concrete Contractors, Inc. and D.M. Sabia, Inc. (mason) continued construction of the foundations and walls of the west and east buildings. Foundation excavation spoils are being loaded into tri-axle dump trucks for export offsite. Concrete trucks and the mason's equipment primarily remained on the paved and stoned sections of the lot, discarded portland based materials were placed in the prescribed dumpster(s).					
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
